A few questions a believer of Jesus should ask themselves prayerfully and honestly each day!

Have I done anything that causes shame or hurt to my lovely Jesus? If so, have I earnestly asked his forgiveness and returned to his protection, and abiding safely under his wing and under his blood because sin separates us from God!

Isaiah 59: ² But your iniquities have separated between you and your God, and your sins have hid his face from you, that he will not hear.

None of us are guaranteed or promised a tomorrow or a next breath, so am I living 100% for him?

Proverbs 27:1 Boast not thyself of to morrow; for thou knowest not what a day may bring forth. James 4:13-14 ¹³ Go to now, ye that say, To day or to morrow we will go into such a city, and continue there a year, and buy and sell, and get gain:

¹⁴ Whereas ye know not what shall be on the morrow. For what is your life? It is even a vapour, that appeareth for a little time, and then vanisheth away.

Am I living a life holy and pleasing to my God, including your conversations?

1Peter 1:15-16 ¹⁵ But as he which hath called you is holy, so be ye holy in all manner of conversation;

¹⁶ Because it is written, Be ye holy; for I am holy.

How many people have I witnessed to by actions, by deeds or by mouth by the leading of the Holy Spirit today?

Mark 16:15-16 ¹⁵ And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature

¹⁶ He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.

You are not called to be silent, but to boldly, yet softly at times declare the name of Jesus Christ and his blessed gift of Salvation and eternal life. Am I doing this?

Matthew 28:19-20 ¹⁹ Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost:

²⁰ Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world. Amen.

Am I coming out from among the world, and separating myself from its sin, or am I ashamed of him?

2 Corinthians 6: ¹⁷ Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the Lord, and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you.

Romans 1: ¹⁶ For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek.

Am I living a life of faith?

Romans 1: ¹⁷ For therein is the righteousness of God revealed from faith to faith: as it is written, The just shall live by faith.

Hebrews 11: ⁶ But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.

Do I love him more than anything else including family as I am commanded to do?

Matthew 10: ³⁷ He that loveth father or mother more than me is not worthy of me: and he that loveth son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me.

Am I spending quality time in prayer? If you love someone, you should want to spend time with them.

Psalms 63: 1-8 O God, thou art my God; early will I seek thee: my soul thirsteth for thee, my flesh longeth for thee in a dry and thirsty land, where no water is;

- ² To see thy power and thy glory, so as I have seen thee in the sanctuary.
- ³Because thy lovingkindness is better than life, my lips shall praise thee.
- ⁴ Thus will I bless thee while I live: I will lift up my hands in thy name.
- ⁵ My soul shall be satisfied as with marrow and fatness; and my mouth shall praise thee with joyful lips:
- ⁶ When I remember thee upon my bed, and meditate on thee in the night watches.
- ⁷Because thou hast been my help, therefore in the shadow of thy wings will I rejoice.
- ⁸ My soul followeth hard after thee: thy right hand upholdeth me.

Honestly ask yourself these questions and ask the Holy Spirit to search your heart and life and reveal to you, in Jesus' name if you are lacking in any of these areas! Because if you are not living as God has called you to live, and Jesus returns, then you will be left behind! He will not allow his bride that he takes back with him to have any spots on her garment at all. No sin shall ever enter heaven's gates.
