Training your ears to hear and know his voice (CEB Translation) revisited.

So, today the Holy Spirit has laid it upon my heart to discuss with you how to train your ears to hear His voice; and to know that it is Him that you are talking to. God (Jesus Christ) wants us to have a relationship with Him. But how do you do that without knowing his voice to communicate with him to begin with? God has given you the very questions to ask the spirits to know. So, let's begin ask the Holy Spirit, God, or Jesus Christ whatever it is you want to know. Wait for an answer. They are not always loud, but an answer will be given. After this you will need to test the spirits to know who they are and who they serve.

The Bible tells us not to believe every spirit that we hear. But to test them and see if they are of God or not. And how you do this is to ask the spirit that is communicating with you, "Did Jesus Christ come as a Human (come in the flesh for other bible readers KJV.CSB)?" If the spirit confesses or says yes that Jesus Christ has come as a human (come in the flesh) then it is of God. If it denies, says no, or confesses that Jesus Christ did not come as a human (come in the flesh) it's of the devil (the deceiver) or the antichrist (the spirit of error).

His word also tells us to ask the spirit if Jesus Christ is the Son of God or if he was sent by God. If the spirit confesses yes to Jesus Christ being sent from God or him being the Son of God, it's of God. If the spirit denies that Jesus Christ came from God or that He is not the Son of God, then it is not of God. The very reason you ask the questions is to be clear what spirit you are talking to. And if you want reassurance that this spirit is of God still, find out who it serves by asking the spirit if Jesus Christ is its Lord? If it serves the Lord Jesus Christ it has the Holy Spirit and will say yes. If it says no the spirit does not serve Jesus Christ and does not have the Holy Spirit. Because nothing

can professthis if they do not have the Holy Spirit. This is exactly what Jesus was referring to in the Scriptures about sheep knowing his voice and another they will not follow. This is the training for you to know how to hear, who to follow, and who to ignore. Let's get all the scriptures to back this up.

The Word confirming to not believe in every spirit but test them, see if they are of God.

1 John 4:1 CEB

1. Dear friends, don't believe every spirit. Test the spirits to see if they are from God because many false prophets have gone into the world.

Testing of the spirits section:

Whom to follow the good shepherd's voice

1 John 4:2 CEB

2 This is how you know if a spirit comes from God: every spirit that confesses that Jesus Christ has come as a human is from God.

Who to ignore: any other voice that's not His

2 John verse 7 CEB

7. Many deceivers have gone into the world who do not confess that Jesus Christ came as a human being. This kind of person is the deceiver and the antichrist.

The next question you should ask the spirit: Was Jesus Christ sent by God? Or is Jesus Christ the Son of God?

- 1 John 4:3 CEB
- 3. <u>and every spirit that doesn't confess Jesus is not from God.</u> This is the spirit of the antichrist, which you have heard is coming and is now already in the world.
- 1 John 2:22-23 CEB
- 22. Who is the liar? Isn't it the person who denies that Jesus is the Christ? This person is the antichrist: the one who denies the Father and the Son.
- 23. Everyone who denies the Son does not have the Father, but the one who confesses the Son has the Father also.

If it denies Jesus Christ is from God or denies him as God's Son, it's the antichrist spirit, The spirit of Error.

Now if it confesses that Jesus Christ is the Son of God or that he came sent by God then it's the Spirit of Truth.

The very reason you ask these questions is to know who or what spirit you are communicating with so your not misled.

1 John 4:6 CEB

6. We are from God. The person who knows God listens to us. Whoever is not from God doesn't listen to us. This is how we recognize the Spirit of truth and the spirit of error.

Finding out who the spirit serves:

No one can say Jesus Christ is there Lord without the Holy Spirit.

(Yes, including spirits)

1 Corinthians 12:3 CEB

3 So I want to make it clear to you that no one says, "Jesus is cursed!" when speaking by God's Spirit, and no one can say. "Jesus is Lord," except by the Holy Spirit.

The red serves the Antichrist: Denies that He is their Lord.

The blue serves Jesus Christ: Accepts and professes that Jesus Christ is their Lord.

Following the Good shepherd (Jesus Christ) and knowing his voice.

John 10:27 CEB

27 My sheep listen to my voice. I know them and they follow me.

John 10:4 CEB

4 Whenever he has gathered all of his sheep, he goes before them and they follow him, because they know his voice.

Ignoring and running away from the stranger's voice (the deceiver and the antichrist)

John 10:5 CEB

4 They won't follow a stranger but will run away because they don't know the stranger's voice."

So, there you have it you folks. Everything that you need to know to start communicating with your Creator. Build that relationship by communication and know His voice. This is exactly how you do that so that you, the sheep are not led astray. The End.
