

## **SEED WAR - DECEPTION RUNS DEEP**

**Matthew 24:4 Take heed that no man deceive you.**

**Genesis 3:15 And I will put enmity between you (serpent) and the woman, and between your seed and her seed; her seed shall crush your head, and you will bruise His heel.**

*(\*This is an in depth study. Get your bible out. Look scriptures up in your own Bible. It's good to do this, to see it in your own Bible. And 2 Corinthians 13:1 - out of 2 or 3 witnesses (scriptures) let every word be established.)*

### **INTRO:**

*This will take some laying of foundation in the Word first. Some of it you may know. Some of it you may not. I pray the Lord God Almighty, in the Name of my Lord Jesus Christ, would open your spiritual eyes and ears, that you would see the truth. I thank You for it, Lord Jesus. (Luke 8:17.)*

*There are many segways that one can take with the information here but one particular area is the focus point at the end. You can pray for the Lord to open your understanding for the other offshoots within this article. Allow the Lord to lead you.*

*The Name: God, when you look it up in Greek means "Theos". It means Elohim and Jehovah in Hebrew. So that is God the Father. It also means the Holy Spirit, Matt. 28:19; Luke 1:35; John 14:16; 15:26; 16:7-14. And according to John 1:1 it also means Jesus, the Son of God. So the use of the word "God" in Biblical texts means all three!*

Since the statement from Matthew 24:4 is made in the end times chapters of the gospels of Matthew, Mark, and Luke, we need to pay serious attention to it. It is after all a **command** from our lovely Jesus for the right-here- and-now. (Luke 21:8; Mark 13:5; also in 2 Thessalonians 2:3.) Let no one deceive you.

The word "let" means we have a part to play in this. We can either choose deception or not. Choose to have the Lord lead you in this no matter what you have been *taught* or what you have *thought*.

Hosea 4:6 My people perish (destroyed) for lack of knowledge: ***because you have rejected knowledge***, I will also reject you, that you shall be no ***priest*** to me: seeing you have forgotten the Law of you God, I will also forget your children.

Revelation 1:5-6 we are made kings and priests unto God, and His Father.

As the Church we have taken that scripture in Hosea in part, the first part only. God is speaking to *His* people! To us! Very stern words. He will reject us if we reject what He is telling us. We have to stay close to Him and forgo our thoughts and ideas, as well as schooling or training. They are not necessarily accurate. Let God be true and every man a liar, as it is written, 'That You may be justified in Your words, and prevail when You judge.' (Romans 3:4).

Also as a precursor to the rest of this article, let's establish what the terms: devil and demon, mean. The definitions come from Vine's Expository Dictionary of Old & New Testament Words.

Devil: accuser, a slanderer. One of the names of satan. Devil and demon are not the same. There is one devil, and there are many demons.

Demon: an inferior deity. (Lower rank.)

### PART 1:

How is it that deception can be so pervasive? And we can't even recognize it... because of being deceived. Being "deceived" means you are not aware of it, at least initially. For a "moment".

But what does your "inner man" say, that "hunch". That's the Holy Spirit. He is Who is leading you (Matthew 4:1; Mark 2:8; Romans 8:14). The Holy Spirit leads by either a "deep-down" uneasy "feeling" or you have "peace" about it (Colossians 3:15). It's that "taking hold together with you, with the Word" in regards to a matter - this what "infirmity" means in Strong's Concordance, the Holy Spirit takes hold together with us with the word, because He is the Spirit and Truth, and the Word is Truth (Romans 8:16, 26, 31; John 1:1-2; John 4:23-24; John 17:17;), letting you know when something is "right" or "wrong". You may not realize that deception is

happening at first but you still have that “uneasiness” about it; or you are purposely avoiding looking at the truth. It’s that simple. It’s either one or the others. It is always simple with the Lord.

In 2 Thessalonians 2:10-12 with all deceivableness of unrighteousness in them that perish; **because they received not the love of the truth**, that they might be saved. 11 And for this cause God shall send them strong delusion, **that they should believe a lie**; 12 **that they all might be damned who believed not the truth**, but had pleasure in unrighteousness.

Those words are very strong!

And in it there is one point I will bring out... it is still a “choice”: “they **should** believe a lie.” They *chose* to believe it, whether they admit it or not. “should” means a conditional or contingent act or state. This means it is up to the person what they will choose, life or death, blessing or cursing. (Deuteronomy 30:19-20.) We are to cleave to the Lord, to love Him and to obey Him, to choose Him. He is life. satan is death. It’s always that simple. One or the other.

Well, we are not in the “camp” of those who believe a lie and choose satan, praise God!! Praise the Lord, we choose Him. We choose life. He is teaching us!

Now, take this along with Matthew 7:22-23 Many will say to Me in that day, ‘Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Your Name, cast out demons in Your Name, and done many wonders in Your Name?’ 23 And then I will declare to them, **‘I never knew you**; depart from Me, you who practice lawlessness.

There is something critically important in Matthew 7:22-23 - that is: **works that appear as being of the Lord can be done in Jesus’ Name and seemingly by the Holy Spirit BUT they are not. Nor are those who do these things a part of the Body of Christ!!! Even though they use His Name.** Take this with John 10:27, My sheep hear My voice, *I know them*, and they follow Me. Clearly, these people are not His sheep. They don’t

know Him. Nor do they hear from Him. Yet, they are *using* the Name of Jesus to do signs and wonders. Hold on to this...we will address this later.

Last part with this: The Name of Jesus *IS* all power!!! BUT how much power is seen by use of Jesus' Name depends on the user. With true Christian people, it has far more power, unlimited. For those that are not His sheep, many signs can be seen by using the Name of Jesus because it is a "container" of the power of God. Yes, even witchcraft wielders, yielders, and users can use the Name of Jesus to accomplish things. But not to the degree as a true child of God. This is a first part of the deception. Christians never thought that evil people would use the Name of Jesus but they can, and do.

Don't be deceived by people who use the Name of Jesus. Listen to the Holy Spirit within first, then look at the "fruit". When someone is not right with the Lord, they can't hide it. Eventually it will be seen by what surrounds their life.

Remember, God looks on the heart. Not on the outside, the facade. (1 Samuel 16:7.)

So, let's move on.

### PART 2:

It is blatantly obvious in these end times that deception is rampant from what things we do know and see; and the only way we cannot be deceived is if we stay close to the Lord Jesus Christ, His Word, and the Holy Spirit's promptings and leadings. This is imperative. But what about what we don't see?

All we have to do is ask. Ask the Heavenly Father, in the Name of Jesus, to reveal all things to us and we will do whatever He tells us to do. (John 14:13-15.)

Deception comes from the "deceiver" who is the father of lies, satan, whose original name is lucifer. The word "satan" according to Vine's

Expository Greek and Hebrew Words means: adversary. All enemies of our Lord Jesus Christ are “adversaries”. This includes all the fallen ones, their offspring, and their creations. Yes, they have created offspring as well - hybrids, clones, A.I. and so on. He is the accuser of the brethren and he has come to steal, kill, and destroy (John 10:10); god of this world; that old serpent - and the serpent is more crafty than any of the fallen ones in Genesis 3:1 - the term “beast” in that verse stands for the fallen ones and their offspring which I will note in the next paragraph. He is also called the red dragon; prince of this world; prince of devils; power of the air; ruler of darkness; original sinner; murderer. This is true for him as well as the others from the kingdom of darkness with the same motive to steal, kill, and destroy, and they transform themselves into an angel of light. Let’s not forget that he/they form(s) weapons and what are these weapons for...to destroy the children of God and to attempt to beat the Lord Jesus Christ, God the Father, and the Holy Spirit. These weapons are not just spiritual ones either. They have physical ones too. Look at the physical arsenal in human warfare. This is only one part.

(Revelation 12:10; John 10:10; 1 Peter 5:8; 2 Corinthians 4:4; Revelation 12:9; Isaiah 14:12; Revelation 12:3; John 14:30; Matthew 12:24; Ephesians 2:2; Ephesians 6:12; 1 John 3:8; Isaiah 54:17.)

Genesis 3:1 the serpent was more crafty than any **beast** of the field which the Lord God had made.

There is much to Genesis 3:1. We know the serpent - satan, who is the red dragon, (Revelation 12:3, 9) is more crafty than all the “beasts” - otherwise known as fallen ones. Recall Revelation 13:1-2. The Lord is very specific in the use of words. He is not flippant about it. When He speaks, He creates. And when He uses a particular word, there is a reason. And He is consistent with how He uses that word throughout the Bible.

The Biblical term “beasts” in Genesis 3:1 signifies the fallen ones. Vines: denotes “living beings” (zöe - life), creatures, and unclean creature, evil creature. \*TAKE NOTE: all that God created are “living beings”. Including the fallen ones. They are HIS creation. All of them. Even though they disobeyed and rebelled. They are called the “**sons of God**” as in Genesis 6:2, 4; Job 1:6 2:1; 38:7. Again, not all the angels rebelled. Only a third according to Revelation 12:4. They are all sons of God. We will get back to this point later.

God doesn't make things of "darkness" or "void" and all of the other synonyms that go with those words. God *is* light (1 John 1:5) He *IS* light. There is no darkness in Him. And He *IS* life (John 1:1-5, 11:25).

Looking at Genesis 1:1-2 means something already occurred before God made the heavens and the Earth, because the Earth was without form, and void; and darkness was upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God, the Holy Spirit, was "brooding" upon the waters!!! He was upset at what happened. There is much to this but like I said earlier, there are many segways you can take if the Lord leads. Ask The Lord to reveal it to you.



The Book of Enoch speaks of 200 angels who made a covenant with one another to rebel against what God has told them to do as "overseers" or rulers over the Earth. It's like any king over a kingdom - he will appoint overseers to rule over parts of the kingdom, and will have them report on how things go in their regions. Same thing here. These angels were appointed as overseers, to protect, and keep charge of the regions they were appointed to. But instead many of them chose to take women of the Earth and breed with them *to create their own* offspring, as Genesis 3:15 and Genesis 6 states. The seed of the serpent, the evil ones, producing their own offspring. This is why the judgment of the Lord against them for this was the flood of Noah, to destroy what they had done. This included the animals. The fallen ones not only bred with humans but with animals. This is why no matter where the country is on the planet, they all have the same mythological kinds of creatures like centaurs, mermaids, satyrs, griffons, and all other hybrids of mythology. This is why God had to choose the animals to go onto the ark, Genesis 6:11-13, 17, 19-20. Looking at verse 19-20 we see that the Lord was *who* brought the animals to the ark: 19 You are to bring into the ark two of all living creatures, male and female, to keep them alive with you. 20 Two of every kind of bird, of every kind of animal and every kind of creature that moves along the ground ***will come to you*** to be kept alive. The animals didn't just "show up" of their own accord. The Lord brought them to the ark. And if you read all of chapter 6 and 7, some "unclean" animals were allowed on the ark. In chapter 7:15-16 it says "all flesh". Doesn't mean it's all Godly. Move on to verse 21, says "all flesh died that moved on the Earth." And we know why God

sent the flood, to destroy the corruption on the Earth. Why? The seed war had already begun. There was no going back.

As you look through the Old Testament you find two major judgments of the Lord are floods and fires. And He uses many more like: war, famine, plagues, hail, brimstone (from volcanoes), earthquakes, waters being turned to blood, and pestilence. And as Ecclesiastes 1:9 says, what God has done before He will do again. And we are seeing these things now. Judgment.

There were many more than the 200 who rebelled in heaven. Revelation 12:4 says that he brought one-third of the stars (representing angels, from Revelation 1:20) who rebelled with him. And Jehovah God, The Great I AM, has an enumerable amount of angels (Hebrews 12:22). The one-third are far more than 200. The 200 were only a segment of them. The amount of angels who rebelled with the devil there is no number that we have from scripture; and there are their offspring; and their creations. What is the dark kingdom creating all of this for... Armageddon. Because he believes that he will win that fight with hybrids, super soldiers, dimensional beings, AI, and such like. The deception is upon the devil and his hierarchy to believe THE lie.



Back to Genesis 3:1, The Lord God takes responsibility here, as well as Isaiah 54:17, for having created the devil and his hierarchy - the demons. It was not The Lord God's desire for them to do what they did. It is just like any parent who's kids are rebellious and doing things the parents do not want them to do. This is what happened. This has to do with "free-will". The Lord God will never force anyone or any creature to do His will. It is their choice. He is about free choice.

John 8:44 You are of your father the devil, and the lust of your father you will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is not truth in him. When he speaks a lie, he speaks of himself; for he is a liar, and the father of it.

There are important details in Ezekiel 28:11-19 about the devil:

The word of the Lord came to me: 12 “Son of man, take up a lament concerning the king of Tyre and say to him: ‘this is what the Sovereign Lord says:

“‘You were the seal of perfection,  
full of wisdom and perfect in beauty.

13. You were in Eden,  
the garden of God;  
every precious stone adorned you;  
carnelian, chrysolite and emerald, topaz, only and jasper, lapis lazuli,  
turquoise and beryl.

Your settings and mountings were made of gold;  
on the day your were created they were prepared.

14 You were anointed as guardian cherub,  
for so I ordained you.

You were on the holy mount of God;  
you walked among the fiery stones.

15 You were blameless in your ways  
from the day you were created  
till ***wickedness was found in you.***

16 Through your widespread trade  
you were filled with violence,  
and you sinned.

So I drove you in disgrace from the mount of God,  
and I expelled you, guardian cherub,  
from among the fiery stones.

17 Your heart became proud  
on account of your beauty,  
and your corrupted your wisdom  
because of your splendor.

So I threw you to the earth;  
I made a spectacle of you before kings.  
18 By your many sins and dishonest trade



you have desecrated your sanctuaries.  
So I made a fire come out from you,  
and it consumed you,  
and I reduced you to ashes on the ground  
in the sight of all who were watching.  
19 All the nations who knew you are appalled at you;  
you have come to an horrible end  
and will be no more.’”

In verse 12 we see that satan/lucifer was sealed. He was full of wisdom and perfect in beauty. Means he was smart and gorgeous. And he was sealed. But he lost that seal by his choices. It's always about choice. If he had maintained the seal, it would have wreaked havoc in heaven. God had to remove it.

In verse 13 he was in the Garden of Eden and was a *guarding angel*, a cherub. Which means he intended to protect and guard; and had a flaming sword and wings: Genesis 3:24 “cherubims” is plural for cherub; and Exodus 25:18-20 God told Moses to create the figures of the cherubim with wings. Means cherubs have wings. They are mighty. They are not fat little babies you see in renaissance paintings.

He was also adorned with gemstones.

Verse 14, he was on the holy mount of God, in heaven. He was an overseer of the Garden of Eden. In the heavenlies. Remember he was cast down in verse 16-17 and Revelation 12:7-10, this battle in heaven with Michael occurred before our Earth was created. Job 1:7 and 2:2 says he was roaming the Earth. So he had already been cast down.

Verse 15 he was perfect when God made him. *BUT* wickedness found in him. God did not intend for him to do what he did. Again, free-will.

Verse 16 we can tell he was up to spreading the violence and conniving others to follow him and rebel against God. We don't know how long this

took but it wasn't instant. God drove him in disgrace from the other angels and his job as overseer of the Garden of Eden was revoked.

Verse 17 he was made a spectacle of by God in front of the "kings". These were the beings, the "elders" that were before humans. Look at Revelation 5:11 and many other places in Revelation.

Verses 18-19. I'm still seeking the Lord on verse 18. There are layers to scripture so it may mean at least two different segments. One may be the actual time that he was cast out of heaven; but it could mean at Armageddon as it says in 2 Thessalonians 2:8 that his wickedness will be revealed with the breath of Jesus' mouth. I am leaning to this one because of this scripture and Revelation 19:15-16; 20:7-10.

### PART 3

Let's take a look at the definition of "deceiver": one who deceives, one who leads into error, a cheat, an impostor, a person who lies or deceives, someone who leads you to believe something that is not is not true.

When you look at "who" he is and his very nature it gives a greater depth to see how far this can go. Identifying the enemy in greater depth so we can understand how this deceptions permeates everything that is not of God. The deception runs deep. But God is greater and nothing shall remain hidden.

2 Corinthians 2:11 Lest satan should get an advantage of us: for we are not ignorant of his devices.

What Paul spoke about here was that he and the people with him were not ignorant of the devil's devices. I say that because of Hosea 4:6...

Again Hosea 4:6 My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge; because you have rejected knowledge, I will also reject you, that you shall be no

priest to me; seeing you have forgotten the law of your God, I will also forget your children.

Since God said His people perish for lack of knowledge, He means it. And they **chose** not to know. Like many Christians today who do not want to learn warfare or how to defeat the devil, when we are commanded to take Authority over him: Luke 10:17-19; Mark 16:17-18 - in Mark the **first thing** Christians are to do is cast out devils!!! And this scripture is a mandate for Christians. And there are so many more: Resist the devil and he shall flee - James 4:7. BUT the first part of that scripture in James says to "Submit yourself to God." The devil won't flee if you don't submit to God. What does that mean? Putting aside your wants, for His wants. That simple. His will be done. Just like Jesus when He was in Gethsemane. Your will be done not My will.



So let's back track a bit. We know he's a deceiver who forms weapons in order to steal, kill, and destroy. Yes, literally. Also in other ways. Steal from our lives like happiness and satisfaction, steal health, kill peace, destroy family relationships and such like. Whatever is not good, you know who is behind it.

We also know from 2 Corinthians 10:3-6 that our weapons are not carnal. They are not of this "realm" or this world. But they are mighty through God to the pulling down of strongholds. How do we pull down strong holds and what are strong holds?

These strongholds as the rest of verses 4-6 say are in your mind. If your are not taking authority over your thoughts you cannot progress to the next stage. And if that is not happening, then we cannot know the devil's devices. Nor can we know his weapons. One of the first steps in spiritual warfare is monitor your thoughts.

### Basic Steps:

1. Submit to the Lord (James 4:7).
2. Guard your thoughts by casting evil thoughts down and replacing them with the Word. Have to put the Word in to change the mind and heart (2 Corinthians 10:3-6).
3. Resist the devil (James 4:7).
4. Endure temptation (James 1:2-4). Temptation comes it does not come from God James 1:13 but comes when we are tempted by our own lust James 1:14. How do you respond to temptation - with the Word. Talk to that temptation that first occurs in your mind. Talk to your mind with the Word Matthew 4:1-11.
5. Trials will come. The Lord tests us but He always provides a way of escape: 1 Corinthians 10:13; Deuteronomy 8:2; Psalm 7:9; 66:10; Jeremiah 17:10.

### PART 4

Hebrew 4:12-13, For the **Word of God is** quick, and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is **a discerner** of the thoughts and intents of the heart. 13 Neither is there **any creature** that is not manifest in His sight; but all things are naked and opened unto the eyes of Him with whom we have to do.

We see from these verses of scripture the Word is alive, or “quick” as the KJV says. It’s not just words on a page. It is ALIVE. IT IS SHARP. Which means it can cut. Separate things that are together. On the surface it looks fine but when you put the thing you are questioning in line with the Word and talking with the Lord about it, it will be divided by the Word to show you what is really going on. And it will help you discern “creatures”. Seed of the serpent versus seed of the woman. Put this with what I mentioned earlier: Matthew 7:22-23 Many will say to Me in that day, ‘Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Your Name, cast out demons in Your Name, and done many wonders in Your Name?’ 23 And then I will declare to them, ‘**I never knew you**; depart from Me, you who practice lawlessness.

Let's take a look at Matthew 24:24 NIV (also repeated in Mark 13:22) - For false messiahs (chirsts) and false prophets will appear and perform great signs and wonders to deceive, if possible, even the elect.

We can see Matthew 24:24; Mark 13:22; and Matthew 7:22-23 are speaking of the same "people".

Let's look at this even more closely...

"Messiah" is the Hebrew word for "Christ". They mean the same thing. And the translation in English from those words is: "Anointed One". The term "Christian" means "Anointed ones".

And the term "Jesus Christ" or "Christ Jesus" means: "Jesus the Anointed One" or "The Anointed Jesus". If we look at John 1:32 Then John gave this testimony: "I saw the Spirit come down from heaven as a dove and remain on Him." In Matthew 3:13 Then Jesus came from Galilee to the Jordan to be baptized by John 14 But John tried to deter Him, saying, "I need to be baptized by You, and do You come to me?" 15 Jesus replied, "Let it be so now; it is proper for us to do this to fulfill all righteousness." Then John consented. 16 As soon as Jesus was baptized, He went up out of the water. At that moment heaven was opened, and he was the Spirit of God descending like a dove and alighting on Him. 17 And a voice from heaven said, "this is My Son, whom I love; with Him I am well pleased." 4:1 THEN Jesus was led by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil.

1 John 2:20, 20 you are Anointed by the Holy Spirit. Jesus was filled with the fulness of the Holy Spirit, the Anointing.

There is much here, but for now we will focus on one thing: Jesus was/is Anointed by the Holy Spirit, and the term "Jesus Christ" and "Christ Jesus" are different operations of the Anointing at work in what Jesus taught in scripture. More precisely, when you look at scripture that uses "Jesus Christ" it is speaking of the fulness of the Anointing which is resurrection power!!! All verses that use that are referring to the resurrection power of God and what it does!

Let's take a look at the first thing Jesus preached after the 40 days of being tempted: Luke 4:18-19. It comes from Isaiah 61:1-2 talking about what the Anointing is there to do - to make people free from the bondage of satan!! In all ways! Spiritually and physically.



Going back to Matthew 24:24 about “false christs/messiahs” - this means “false anointed ones” or false christians. Not only “false Jesus”...of which there have been some. But not as many as false christians. They talk a good talk. Use scripture. Even use the Name of Jesus as Matthew 7 says... but what does the Holy Spirit inside you say? That still, small, quiet voice, prompting, leading (1 Kings 19:11-12).

The second part to verse 24, “false prophets”: yes, we know there are many false prophets out there. Many. And yes, they are deceiving many Christians because these people are not listening to the Holy Spirit within them. Get quiet with the Lord and ask Him who is true and who is false.

But there is another part to this. Look at 1 Corinthians 14 and 2 Peter 2:1 (all of 2). “Prophecy” in general means “inspired utterance.” In 1 Corinthians 14 it's about using the Holy Spirit gifting of prophetic utterance in Church to teach. Meaning, “inspired” teachers and preachers. Of which there are many false teachers and preachers currently in the Church today.

This is the bigger picture of Matthew 24:24 - for there shall arise many false Christians and false teachers in the Church, who talk a “good game” but are not what they are playing to be. They use scripture, use the Name of Jesus, but when the proverbial “rubber meets the road” it's not leaving you with any peace in your heart by the Holy Spirit. Allow Him to be the ultimate Judge.

This includes all parts of the Church: pastors and their wives, teachers, preachers, worship leaders/musicians, prayer team leaders/members, and church members. It's an infiltration. Of course the enemy wants to infiltrate and annihilate the Church. Especially effective ones in the things of God. You know these churches are on a target list of the enemy.

For any true man and woman of God in the Church, be sure to hunker down with the Lord and have Him let you show who is right and who is wrong in your church...and call them out **as the Lord leads**. Don't just do it until the Lord tells you. This will take steady prayer to find out what the Lord wants you to do. You have to have real pray-ers for your ministry. Real worship. Real inspired utterance and not from the spirit of divination, jezebel and the marine kingdom, and so many others that plague the Church today.

### PART 5

If you have gotten this far, praise God! This is intense. I know...these are things that the Lord has shown us. And there is one more part.

Remember back, near the beginning, I mentioned "sons of God". They were all created by God. Including the fallen ones. And this world, this life, is about a "seed war" that God announced in Genesis 3:15.

#### 1 John 4:1-4 NIV

Dear friends, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits to see whether they are **from God**, because many false prophets have gone out into the world.

2 This is how you can recognize the Spirit of God: Every spirit that acknowledges that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh **is from God**,  
3 but every spirit that does not acknowledge Jesus is not from God. This is the spirit of antichrist, which you have heard is coming and even now is already in the world.

4 You, dear children, are from God **and have overcome them**, because the One who is in you is greater than the one who is **in the world**.

Okay... let's unpack this. And if you got this far, I am convinced the Holy Spirit is already showing this to you.

Seed war. Seed of the serpent versus the seed of the woman (those created by God). Yes, the seed of the woman is specifically referring to Jesus in Genesis 3:15. The added layer is the true human seed created by God, not the serpent's seed. Not a creation from the devil and his kingdom, like Genesis 6-7, which God wiped out once...technically Genesis 1:1-2, it's twice.

Stick with me...

Fallen ones are sons of God. (This is why the devil presented himself in "roll call" of the sons of God in Job 1 & 2. He was used to doing that.) Sons of God were created by God Almighty. They are originally from His seed. Sin has messed up the fallen angels but they are still created by Him. 1 John 4 is talking about the seed war, serpent seed cannot say Jesus Christ has come in the flesh. None of the spawn of the dark kingdoms can say it. They are of the seed of the serpent. BUT fallen ones can!!!

The seed of God is still in them. Which means the seed of the Holy Spirit is still in them. They still have breath.

And the antichrist, as 1 John 4 says cannot acknowledge Jesus. Refuses to say the Name of Jesus. The antichrist is from the seed of the serpent. No, he is not savable. Revelation 19:20.

Look at 1 Corinthians 12:3:

Therefore I want you to know that no one who speaking by the Spirit of God says, "Jesus be cursed," and no one can say, "Jesus is Lord," except by the Holy Spirit.

But fallen angels can!! They were created by God...not the serpent.

Hybrid type creatures of the serpent are the ones that will be blatantly obvious by not being able to say "Jesus is Lord" or that "Jesus Christ came in the flesh." Or even acknowledge His Name. But fallen angels can.



HOWEVER, the Holy Spirit within you will reveal all things. There are things that just don't "match up" if you have a fallen angel in your life. Like, someone you know may talk about scripture or pray in Jesus Name, or even ask you to pray for them - but they don't like listening to true Godly teachers; or true Godly worship music. They will be irritated by it. They may even put you down for listening to these things. Their emotions will be erratic. Like a roller coaster, especially with expressions of meanness, being degrading and making fun of you, or the Godly preacher or teacher, or worship music.

Hebrews 13:2 do not forget to entertain strangers, for by doing some have unwittingly entertained angels...good ones and bad ones. Go to Genesis 18:1-2 and Genesis 32:22-32, angels in human form. There are times in scripture where they are referred to as "men". With this in mind look at Matthew 7:15 Beware of false prophets, who come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravenous wolves. Remember, "prophets" mean inspired utterance and can be a pastor or teacher, they are involved in the church, and in the Body of Christ; and they are simply demon possessed, they can be, and they can also be fallen ones.

Let's add one more part that the Lord showed. It helps make more sense of this.

Matthew 8:28-29:

And when He was come to the other side into the country of the  
Gadarenes,  
there met Him two possessed with demons, coming out of the tombs,  
exceeding fierce,  
so that no man might pass by that way.  
29 And behold, **they cried out** saying, "**What have we to do with you,  
Jesus the Son of God?**  
Are You come here to torment us before the time?

These devils/demons (different translations use either word), announced, spoke, that He was Jesus, the Son of God.

Reminder, “devils/demons” are all part of the fallen angels. Different rank and file, order of evil ones.

Mark 1:23-25:

And there was **in their synagogue** a man with an unclean spirit; and he cried out,

24 Saying, “Let **us** alone; **what have we to do with you, Jesus of Nazareth?** Are You come to destroy us?”

**I know You  
Who You are,  
The Holy One of God.**

25 And Jesus rebuked him, saying,  
“Hold your peace, and come out of him.”

Notice this happened in church!! Yes, demons/devils in church. If your not dealing with them in your church, then you can guarantee they are there.

Again, the demons/devils publicly stated Jesus’ Name, where He was born, and that He is the Holy One of God.

Back to 1 John 4, cannot be about fallen angels but the seed of the serpent.

Last one:

James 2:19 - You believe that there is one God. Good! Even the demons (devils) believe that and tremble.

How did James know that both demons and devils believed in God, because he saw many who were cast out.

It is the seed of the serpent who cannot acknowledge Jesus, His coming in the flesh because that shows the victory our Lord Jesus Christ achieved over them, and they cannot say “Jesus is Lord”...but fallen ones *can* say all of these things.

This is why the deception is so deep!! But now the Lord is revealing according to Luke 8:17! Praise God!



The Days of Noah are important to understand, Genesis chapters 6-9, in these last days. Let's look at Matthew 24:37-39, because all of this culminates to exactly where we are now:

37 As it was in the days of Noah, **so it will be at the coming of the Son of Man.**

38 For in the days before the flood, **they ("people")** were eating and drinking, **marrying and giving in marriage**, up to the day Noah entered the ark; 39 and they knew nothing about what would happen until the flood came and took them all away. That is how it will be at the coming of the Son of Man.

From Genesis 6 we see that days of Noah were about fallen angels marrying whomever they chose. Angels can present themselves as "male" or "female". It is the same in this very time. This very "hour".

Notice many times in scripture angels are referred to as "men" or in NIV it says "people". Because they will appear as people. Hebrews 13:2 good and bad angels appear and we entertain them and as Matthew says, will be marrying and giving in marriage - means these angels are on both roles, "husbands", "wives", "fathers" and "mothers".

This scripture is repeated in Luke 17:26-30, this is two witnesses 2 Corinthians 13:1.



As with all we speak about, take it to the Lord if you are unsure in your spirit...technically, in your mind, as Colossians 3:15 in Amplified Translation says: And let the **peace** (soul harmony) which comes from **Christ rule** (act as umpire continually) in your hearts [**deciding and settling with finality all questions that arise in your minds**, in that peaceful state] to which as [member of Christ's] one body you were also

called [to live]. And be thankful (appreciative), [giving praise to God always].

Meaning, ask the Lord about the questions rolling around in your mind. Take the scripture. Pray about them and see how the Lord leads.
