



aking mistakes is a common phenomenon in human relationships. Nobody can M say he or she has not made a mistake before. Everyone makes mistakes but how the mistake is handled is what makes all the difference. More so, the extent of the mistake determines the remedy that will be recommended, if necessary.

There are mistakes one falls into that brings about feelings of guilt which may be difficult to forget. These are nagging feelings that tug at the heart, sometimes making terrible suggestions which just lead the person deeper into the mess. Some mistakes are not even pardonable; they are too expensive to be reversed. I have taken my time to spell out some of these errors so that you will be familiar with them in order to escape them. Truly, in a matter such as this, 'prevention is better than cure'. Even if you eventually get rescued from the grip of the errors, the scars they leave behind remain. Hence, it's better you don't get yourself in the mess. Continuously lamenting over your mistakes is also not ideal as this will negatively affect your emotions. You will then begin to perceive yourself as a bad, inferior, or disfavoured person, and this leads to low self-esteem. If this bad perception of yourself persists in your subconscious long enough, you will begin to behave in ways that agree with it. Thereafter, your actions will lead to more negative decisions which also lead to even more mistakes. You will then become a truly bad, inferior or disfavored person. This is called the downward spiral. It is a big issue when things turn out this way.

Let's search the Scriptures together:

As a dog returneth to his vomit, so a fool returneth to his folly. Prov.26:11

In modern day English, what this simple statement means is that, like a dog that returns to its vomit, is a fool who repeats his or her mistakes. Again;

For whatsoever things were written aforetime were written for our learning, that we through patience and comfort of the scriptures might have hope. Romans 15:4

SOME FACTS ABOUT MISTAKES


1. All men make mistakes but only fools repeat them.

- 2. The cheapest education in life is to benefit from the mistakes of others. You come across someone who has made a mistake and you study him or her to make sure you do not fall into the same errors. It costs you nothing to learn from the experience someone is going through or has gone through. It is only by mere observation hence it's cheapness. The Chinese have a saying that: "Cheat me once, shame on you; cheat me twice, shame on me". This means, if I allow you to repeat what you first did to me that deprived me, then I am to blame for it.
- 3. Mistakes are opportunities to learn.
- 4. It takes successive failures to create success; success doesn't just come out of the blues.
- 5. Not getting what you want can be a blessing in disguise. Not getting what you want is sometimes a wonderful act of divine intervention because it forces you to re-evaluate things thereby opening new doors to opportunities and information you would have otherwise overlooked. Remember, some things in life fall apart so that better things can fall together.
- 6. Never regret anything because every detail of your life, including your mistakes, is a totality of who you are today.
- 7. Winston Churchill reminds us that, "Success, is moving from one failure to another with no loss of enthusiasm". Another writer puts it this way, "Success is inverted failures". That means success is a series of mistakes turned inside out.
- 8. The ability to learn firsthand from the experience of others will position you to avoid their mistakes. Mistakes are painful when they happen, but years later, when you learn from them, it leads to success. If it's good, it is going to be wonderful. If it is bad, it is going to be an unfortunate 'experience'. But what we must not ignore is the fact that, it's better never to fall victim of any mistake, at all, whether major or minor. You have to take the good with the bad, smile with the sad, love what you have and be thankful to God for being there. After all, you are still alive so you can make corrections. More so, forgive yourself and others; then you are qualified to move on to the next level. Once you have life, there is hope. God is not through with you yet. He will bring His promises in your life to pass. And so shall it be for you, in the mighty name of Jesus.

THE MISTAKES

Failure to understand that marriage is ultimately about destiny.

Your decision on who to marry is responsible for over ninety percent of your success or failure in life. That is why it is good to do it right the first and only time because it is a destiny decision and not one that should be done based on personal whims and caprices. This is one of the reasons why, on wedding days, some serious injunctions are read to the couples. This implies that the vows they are about committing to are not things to dabble into like brutes without sense. What the priest is saying is that 'I hope you have thought about the decision to marry very carefully before coming to the altar?'

Your destiny is the *reason* why you were born; the ultimate reason why you were brought to life. It is also the *expectation* of heaven for your life; what the Lord has called you to come and *achieve* on this planet. So it is important to note that anybody you marry can either be part of this destiny or against it. Anything anyone does outside his or her destiny is bound for failure no matter how professional he or she handles it. The bottom-line is that, in the region outside your destiny map, the enemy has the right to punish, attack and put you under perpetual bondage. Do not make your marital choice irrationally. As a Christian single, pray first to know who you are meant to be. Once you have a clear picture of your own life, then you are fit to choose who fits into that role of divine partner. Know your destiny. Know your areas of expertise – what you do with relative ease yet difficult for others to achieve. Identify your gifts, talents and calling in God. Most importantly, ask God to show you who He has really made you to be.

Failure to understand that marriage is not a solution to the problem of promiscuity.

Factually, one of the key things involved in the institution of marriage is the pleasure of sex. God placed sex within the confines of marriage for all legally married couples to enjoy and for procreation. But it is a serious mistake for someone to decide to marry simply because he or she has not been able to overcome sexual looseness. The divine order is to enjoy sex in marriage. The promiscuity issue has to be addressed as a problem on its own. Once you take the disciplined steps to overcome it, marriage could come in as part of the processes that gives no room for turning back to your 'vomit'. So do not marry because you need to satisfy your sexual desires, urges or fantasies. Your spouse may not possess the same libido as you. The end-result would be adultery or a total breakdown of the marriage. More so, your sexual desire, or lust for sex, may be greater than desirable. This is called hyper sexuality, sex addiction or satyriasis and the treatment for this is based on relation therapy. That is, what led to it (the cause) will determine the treatment. This could be medical, behavioral or spiritual. If you are a victim of this, take some time, with discipline and proper counseling, to overcome your excessive sexual urge before getting married. Be in charge of your hormones first! Experts say that overexposure to pornography creates unrealistic expectations of the act of sex and this hurts personal relationships (Taylor Wilder: Emerald). So get rid of all pornographic materials. More so, avoid and get disconnected from all the situations and persons that can stimulate you sexually.

I beseech you therefore brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable.

Being consumed with the desire to be married.

If you fall into the category of people that are so keen to get married that they are oblivious of the ugly situations that may rear its head, you are playing with fire. Due to one factor or the other, some people have decided to make getting married a do-or-die affair. They are so desperate that they decide to go for any available option. Beloved, marriage does not work in that way; it is deeper than that. There is a spiritual covenant attached to the institution of marriage which must be understood before embarking on it. This same covenant has its dos and don'ts. They must be strictly followed and obeyed. If not, there will be irrecoverable damage. That you are 'getting old', as you think, does not mean you should be so desperate and in the process jump into murky waters.

You have to be extremely careful because marital errors put a person into a state of absolute regret.

There is no one that enters the fire of marital error and comes out the same, that is if the person comes out alive. The fire burns without mercy. This shall never be your portion, in the mighty name of Jesus.

If you are reading this book right now and you have passed through the fire in a way, I want to encourage you that God's mercy still speaks. But my point here is to let you avoid or escape the fire. If you have not entered into it already, determine never to even feel the flame until God settles you maritally. It may sound very casual to say that God has not forgotten you in the area of marriage but it is the truth. If you have identified with Jesus as your Lord and personal Saviour, He has the responsibility to fix your marital affairs so wait on Him! In most cases, the desperadoes in the area of marriage get disappointed and become less attractive because they are unconsciously transmitting the desperate message. Their facial expression and posture change as well. Doing this is a way of speaking the language of frustration into their lives and bodies. This is so sad. Beloved, is it not better to wait than to get yourself worn-out while alive? Don't be consumed with this 'I must marry now, no matter what' mentality. Rather, get yourself busy working for the Lord and preparing for the marriage itself while you pray along.

But they that WAIT upon the LORD shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint. Isaiah 40:31

Appearing desperate and not valuing yourself.

Beloved you can actually make yourself available without appearing desperate. Note that it is not only the single ladies that are desperate to marry, there are single men too. The reason you are becoming desperate to marry is because you are approaching your late-twenties, thirties or even forties as a single adult. It seems like everyone around you is getting ushered into the world of love and marriage while you are still wondering if you will ever find the God-given man or lady. You are beginning to wonder whether putting your absolute trust in God to bring you the right partner is enough or you might need to "help yourself" in the world of love and dating. If you don't get things right at this stage of your life, things might go bad (God forbid). You may say you don't mind anything, but the truth is that 'anything' cannot make a good marriage. I want to suggest some ways you can show your availability without being desperate; *exchange* your fear for faith, get busy doing the things you love, make new godly friends and don't be shy about singleness.

Lead me in thy truth, and teach me: for thou art the God of my salvation; on thee do I WAIT all the day. Psalm 25:5

Believing that marriage will solve all your problems.

God created love and has placed the desire to be loved unconditionally in each of our hearts. Marriage is a natural overflow of that desire. Yet within this sacred and natural pursuit of marriage, it is easy to fall into the lie that finding a spouse will be the ultimate road to happiness and great satisfaction; that all problems, fears and deficits will fade away in the presence of true love. While this may be true of God's love, let me remind you it isn't true in the world of marriage. Beloved, I must be sincere enough to let you know that marriage is a great blessing and that those who find a good spouse have truly found a great gift (Proverbs 18:22). Having been married for more than twenty years, I can wholeheartedly say that marriage has enriched my life in so many ways. Yet for all the things that it has done to enhance my life and stretch my love, there are still some things it will never be able to do.

Beloved, permit me to re-emphasise that there is no doubt marriage is a great blessing and that those who find a good spouse have truly found a great gift.

Some people fall into the belief that being married and being loved by another will really teach us how to love ourselves. I don't think so.

That way of thinking has done more harm than good to many a marriage today. No one has the power to deal with our inadequacies and insecurities but us. Putting expectations as these on a spouse will only cause harm because there is a high probability they can't change how we view ourselves. No matter how much encouragement, affection, affirmation and validation you receive from your partner, true security comes when you choose to see yourself through the eyes of God. Relying on your partner to fill your insatiable needs is a recipe for disaster because no human being has the capacity to offer you what is needed for true value and self worth. That can only come from within but true security comes from the intimacy of your relationship with God. Re-adjust your mindset, if necessary, and take it away from the fallacy that your potential partner will be your 'financial saviour' or messiah. Know for sure that marriage cannot solve all your problems. It is only God that can do that.

Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not on thine own understanding. Proverbs 3:5

But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you. Matt.6: 33

Making the firstmove, as a lady.

This is one mistake you should never make because it is neither biblical nor acceptable in our society today. The man is the one that is both naturally and spiritually saddled with the responsibility to look for a wife. This is one of the reasons why most men lose respect for the ladies that run after them for a relationship. They believe any lady that does that is selling herself cheap and may not make a responsible wife. Believe me readers, this is true!

As a lady you must position yourself in such a way that you will command respect from men, including your own father.

There is a virtue God put in all ladies – no matter how physically unattractive she may be, a man will look forward to having her in his arms. What a God we serve! As a *lady you must never* approach the guy, even if you are so sure God is saying 'yes'. It is not biblical. Position yourself in such a way that you will command respect from men and never make suspicious moves to get the man's attention. You may lose his love and respect for doing that.

HE who finds a wife finds a good thing, and obtains favour from the LORD. – Proverbs 22:18 NASB

Getting physically involved in a relationship much too soon and going too far before deeply considering what the marriage would look like.

People that fall into this category even fall into sexual immorality, in most cases, before they know it. They allow their feelings and expectations to lead them into being so carried away that the future is given lesser attention.

The truth is that, with time, the excitement fades away, giving room to frustration and regrets.

It is true that having someone of your dream is one of the greatest miracles that could happen to a Christian single person; yet our senses must be subjected to the total control of the Holy Ghost. Think, pray and involve mature Christian brethren before going ahead into any relationship. And more so, only consider courtship at a time in your life when you are ready and mature enough to consider marriage. This is the type of relationship I am referring to.

This I say then, walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh. Galatians 5: 16

For to be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and peace. Because the carnal mind is enmity against GOD; for it is not subject to the law of God; neither indeed can be. Romans 8:6-7

Misinterpreting the attention of the opposite sex.

Desperation to be married can lead many singles to overreact to attention from the opposite sex, especially if that person is attractive to them. If a man looks at a woman twice, the woman can read all kinds of things into it. If a woman happens to sit by a man at a social or church function, the man begins to think she's sending him come-ons. This misinterpretation of attention is one of the major reasons it is so difficult for a single man and woman to have a good platonic relationship that might possibly go deeper and eventually lead to a romantic or marital one.

Some Christian singles truly enjoy sending signals and then disavowing them. Some brothers even go as far as giving observers the impression that something is going on between them and a sister when there is really nothing. This in turn deprives the sister from proposals from potential suitors. This is not good enough. As a young single Christian man or lady, refrain from sending wrong signals to the opposite sex if your intention is not pure or genuine. Don't you ever assume someone is in love with you if he or she doesn't say so. Wait for a proposal before you talk about it.

As for you, my son...know the God your father, and serve Him with a whole heart and a willing mind, for (He) searches all hearts, and understands every INTENTS of the thoughts...If you seek Him, He will let you find Him, if you forsake Him... – 1.Chronicles 28:9

Ignoring danger signals in a relationship.

In my book, 34 *Laws* of *Courtship*, I enumerated and gave brief explanations of some danger signals in courtship or relationship. If at the sight of these signals you still remain passive and move on without a pause for reconsideration and correction then doom is sure. Such signals are brought to your notice, out of grace, so that you don't become a victim. The truth is, most of the time, some singles just do not want to see them. They allow their emotions to get so involved such that they lose focus. Remember that when emotions get involved in a situation, it becomes very easy to lose perspective.

Beloved, you cannot trust your emotions. They fade away when faced by reality.

In any relationship, and especially in courtship, open your physical and spiritual eyes to the things around you. Do not be ruled by emotions but by reasoning. And prayerfully consider your options before taking any step.

The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge, but FOOLS despise wisdom and instructions. – Proverbs 1:7

Failure to discover your purpose before looking for a partner.

You must first of all find out who you are. Understand the purpose of your existence on this planet before you consider marriage at all. This sequence must be strictly followed: *purpose before partner*. It is the discovery of your divine purpose that determines who fits in as a divine partner and who does not. But when you do not have a clue about who God has made you to be, there will be problems.

We preach that a believer *can* only marry another believer - a born-again child of God. But you must also understand that it is not every born-again Christian that will suit your purpose in life. There is someone that can perfectly fit the column of your partner in marriage more than others.

If you do not know your purpose and you bring in someone into that purpose, you will get into trouble.

In Christendom today, there is this common issue with some ministers of the gospel who got married before they got born-again or before they answered the call of God. Their spouses become misfits to the divine agenda of heaven for their lives. This is what would happen to you also if you decide to marry before making the attempt to know God's purpose for your life. Something has gone terribly wrong when young Christians believe their sole purpose in life is to find marital love. This belief is naïve and dangerous. It robs us of true joy and real purpose in life. True purpose is eternal and can never be taken away. But as humans, there is a reason why God created you and I. You need to discover yours.

The Bible encourages us to live this life for God's glory, to love Him and to love others in an attempt to leave His fingerprint all over the entire world. Though marriage can be an incredible gift, it is a just a means to an end and not the end itself. When we see relationships as the last step on our road of purpose, we find ourselves facing a wall of disappointment with nowhere left to go when we finally arrive. Marriage may be an avenue to fulfill our purpose but it is never the final destination. We need to seek God's purpose for our lives far beyond finding a spouse. We must allow His will and His plans to be the course that guides our lives and influences our direction. Rather than asking what God can do for us, we need to look to Him and ask what we can do for Him. In this is true purpose.

Do not be fixated on finding a partner to the detriment of seeking God's divine purpose for your life. Your purpose has to come first. Go extra miles to know your purpose in life.

Once you discover your purpose, use the best of your energy towards achieving it. Read books that talk about your purpose. Choose a mentor that you could look up to who is in the same line as what you intend to achieve with your life. Once you have worked on your purpose to a tangible level then you can begin to map out things for your marriage.

Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: Fear God, and keep His commandments for this is the whole duty of man. Ecclesiastes 12:13

Not seeking for divine direction before stepping out to get who to marry.

If you see someone you like and you desire to marry him or her, or if someone proposes to you, there is nothing wrong in considering the desire or proposal; but you must not leave God out of the equation. In the choice of marriage partner, God must not be left out or else there will be a big problem. God made marriage. He therefore has all it takes to make it perfect. You must consult Him to get the manual on how to make your own marriage a heaven on earth. You have to pray and ask for His opinion about the person.

The truth is that there are people who enjoy their marriage as opposed to popular opinion. In order to fall into this category of people, you need to play certain roles and also give God the room to play His never-failing role too. Some of the things that must be in place at your end is to be mature physically, materially and spiritually. By spiritual maturity, I mean you must have got to a level where you are able to pray and hear God talk to you *clearly.* This experience is not the type where you talk about dreams, or 'I have peace in my heart'. No, it's more than that. Consider the marital process as a walk in a long dark path where you cannot navigate alone; you need the guidance and direction of the Holy Spirit. Don't be intimidated when you hear some people saying; 'the Lord spoke to me'. He can speak to you too beloved. Just make sure you are saved and living in righteousness. Maintain a close relationship with Him by studying your Bible daily and keep a strong prayer altar. If you make this (strong prayer altar) your habit, with time you will begin to develop and identify the different ways the Holy Spirit ministers to Christians, and in particular the way He chooses to minister to you. Then await God's opinion on your marital decision to be made clear to you.

Deciding to marry someone you know you shouldn't because of the fear of not having another suitor or the fear of remaining unmarried and lonely.

Some people begin to count the number of their younger ones that are married and are thereby seriously overwhelmed with fear of remaining single. If you put yourself into a situation like that, it will be difficult for you to either think straight or hear from God. This fear will disturb your prayers and your faith in God. Many rush into relationships as a result of the fear of loneliness. If you rush into marriage because you seem to be lagging behind when all members of your family and friends are getting married, your marriage is likely to end in trouble. Loneliness is a feeling, an attitude. We don't get through this life without experiencing it to some degree. But to settle for anything less or inferior, as a substitute for loneliness is a big mistake. There are worse things than loneliness and by God's grace we do not have to be overcome and defeated by loneliness. He can take our loneliness and turn it into a beautiful, fruitful, productive time with Him. While waiting on God for your lovely spouse, do not give in to the ghost of loneliness. Make your quiet times glorious moments in His Presence. Forsake not the assembly of God's children. You must also recognize that being alone doesn't mean you're a social misfit. Don't buy into the lies of the enemy who wants you to feel desperate. When we feel desperate, we act in irrational and unprincipled ways. Whenever we feel an overpowering need to have someone near, we'll settle for anything. Also recognize your need for social interaction and plan good things. But you don't have to have a date to have company. Reach out to others who have similar interests like you and share your time. Enjoy those people for who they are and you'll discover that the loneliness will fade away.

Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God. And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus. – Philippians 4;6-7

The beautiful thing you must understand here is that God is *ever* in the business of perfect match-making, hence, He can never make mistakes. If He is leading you into a relationship, it means He has searched both of you out before arriving at His conclusion.

Do not settle for anything less than God's best for you. If it will take a whole year to wait till you love him or her before deciding to marry, then, wait you must!

If you have not reached the realm where you love him or her for who he or she is then never you go ahead; the end may never be palatable.

Better is little with the fear of the LORD than great treasure and trouble therewith. – Proverb: 15:16

Better is a little with righteousness than great revenues without right. – Proverb: 16:8

Deciding to go into marriage with someone because of his or her wealth.

Money is good but money is not everything. It can buy you bed but not sleep; money can buy you books but not a brain. There are many valuable things money cannot buy. So don't get carried away because there's money. In most cases, some of those people who run after a man or woman because of money, get into the marriage and are treated shabbily. At this juncture they may begin to wonder where the problem is coming from. But the truth is that they actually initiated and brought the problem upon themselves the moment they made the decision to go into the marriage because of money. Look for finer qualities and Godly character in a person rather than the size of his or her purse before going into marriage relationship. Check for his or her dreams or goals for the future. It could give you clues to what tomorrow would turn out to be for both of you if you choose to marry each other.

Whoever loves money never has money enough; whoever loves wealth is never satisfied with his income. This too is meaningless. Ecc1.5:10 (NIV)

For the love of money is the root of all kinds of evils. Some people eager for money, have wandered from the faith, and pierced themselves with many griefs.1 Timothy 6: 10(NIV)

It is the blessing of the LORD that makes rich, and He adds no sorrow to it. Proverbs 10:22 (NASB)

Premarital Sex.

Any sex outside marriage is a serious mistake; a big error indeed. There are lots of ideologies flying around these days misleading many singles on the concept of marriage. Some say the lady must be pregnant before their son can marry her. Others say you need to sleep with him to be sure that he is not impotent or frigid before you can decide to marry him or her.

Beloved, immediately you begin to sleep with each other before marriage, you have automatically blocked your heavens to hearing or getting attention from God, the Author of marriage. There is no holy principle or precept anywhere that can give you these abominations as part of marital precepts; IT IS SINFUL TO ENGAGE IN SEX WITH A PERSON YOU ARE NOT LEGALLY MARRIED TO. Sex is not allowed outside lawful matrimony. Those people who do it live to face the consequences.

The Bible gives specific instructions against premarital sex because it makes those that indulge in the act abominable in the sight of God. Don't think you can hold down a man by having sex with him. On the contrary, it is away of convincing him of how sexually lose you can be. He will definitely believe you do the same with other men too. If he decides not to marry you because you refuse to gratify him sexually, then let him go, but hold on to your Christian faith. God will never fail you, never!

We Christians have allowed the world system and philosophy to infiltrate our thinking about the physical aspects of a relationship. Romans 12:1-2 says we are 'not to be conformed to this world, but transformed by a renewed mind'.

When we become casual about having sex before marriage, we have allowed ourselves to be cramped into the world's mold.

If you truly want to remain pure in your sexual life and keep yourself for the one person God has ordained for you, or keep yourself for Christ if you remain single, you most certainly can. There is nothing impossible about it.

However, in order to do that, you will need a discipline that I don't see in many singles, a discipline to go the extra mile in keeping physical contact down to a minimum. You simply cannot trust the chemistry of your body. It is very powerful, and once it gets going, finding the discipline to keep it under control is extremely difficult. So the secret is to keep the electricity down to low levels by controlling the physical contacts. It is of necessity to break every relationship that has immorality serving as its foundation. If such relationships lead to marriage, there are fatal consequences. If you are in a relationship where you sleep with each before marriage and both of you still agree to marry, please see your pastor and make sure he or she knows about these sex acts.

Flee from YOUTHFUL LUSTS; but follow righteousness, faith, charity, peace with them that call on the name of the LORD out of a pure heart. – 2 Timothy 2:22

Yielding to pressure.

Many people have made costly mistakes by succumbing to pressure. It could be societal pressure, parental pressure, pressure in the workplace or even pressure in the church. *Don't allow the* opinions of those around you pressurize you into making a mistake that you will live to nurse all the days of your life. To those that constantly ask you whether you are getting married or not, tell them they should get prepared to celebrate with you soonest. Don't allow the vehicle of your life to be controlled by passers-by whose knowledge concerning what God has in store for you is shallow. Or else, if you are not careful, the pressure may push you into making a grave mistake. If possible, stay away from the people that put you under undue pressure to marry, especially parents and so-called loved ones. Always groom yourself well; keep a good demeanor, a calm countenance and a cheerful look always. Continue to pray and wait on the LORD, and very soon your own Boaz will appear.

Using sex to keep a relationship or a partner.

You cannot use sex to keep a man or a woman. If he or she truly loves you, they will wait till the right time. If you give in to sex with him or her, you will be used only for sexual pleasure while the search for marriage partner continues.

It is pathetic if you fall victim of such. Keep yourself pure. If he decides to leave because you are not giving in to sexual advances, then let him. The truth is that he would see you for the rest of his life as a real woman of integrity. Many young people have made this mistake and most have paid dearly for it. Understand that every relationship is a choice and not by force. Also understand that you cannot keep who does not want to stay. If he or she stays physically, there might be emotional absence. The sex thing in the relationship has already defiled it as far as God is concerned. Hence to build a blameless home, stop the relationship, immediately. I suggest you let go after trying your best to sustain your relationship instead of selling yourself cheap by offering sex.

Marriage should be honored by all, and the marriage bed kept pure, for GOD will judge the adulterer and all the sexually immoral. Hebrew 13;4.NN

Deciding to be pregnant for the man in order to make him marry you.

What a silly mistake! The bedrock of a marriage that will be blissful and stand the test of time is *LOVE*. Getting pregnant to tie him down is a way to by-pass all the normal protocols that will allow you build the relationship to yield a lasting marriage. Even if the man marries you because of the pregnancy, he will only be interested in the pregnancy and not you. Do not make this mistake. If you start your home on this wrong foundation you will live to regret it the rest of your days. And the child you are having outside marriage, *as* far as the Bible is concerned, is a bastard. Keep away from all physical contacts that can lead to sexual immorality. These include kissing, hugging, heavy petting, necking, fondling and such likes. The guy can deny the pregnancy thereby turning the lady into a premature parent-a single mother.

He who is pregnant with evil and conceives trouble gives birth to disillusionment.

Psalms 7:14

Marriage is honourable in all, and the bed undefiled: but whoremongers and adulterers God will judge. Heb:13: 4

Looking only for material things before deciding who to marry.

That is, if a man comes to make a marriage proposal, and the decision whether to say yes or not is based on what he has, where he works, the type of car he drives, whether he uses designer wears or not. I must be frank with you, if that is what you look forward to in a man, you are in a big mess already. Know today that material things are very good, but they are not strong enough to sustain the weight of a marriage. Even if the man has nothing today, once you have prayed together in agreement, and you have the backings of heaven, the marriage will be full of prosperity tomorrow. Beloved, be contented with what God has provided for you. *D*o not covet what is not yours. Also know that material possessions does not guaranty that a marriage will be successful.

Understand that God does not create failures or non-achievers, so wait and pray for His choice for you.

Wilt thou set thine eyes upon that which is not? For riches certainly *make themselves wings; they fly away as an eagle toward heaven.* – Proverb: 23: 5

Thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's house, thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor any thing that is thy neighbour's. - Ex:20:17

Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him.

Receiving gifts without knowing the giver very well.

You do not know a man very well or a lady and yet you are taking his or her gifts; this is dangerous because the gifts may be your undoing later. Some ladies have received such gifts and later found it difficult to disconnect the giver who has directly or indirectly bought their will power with the gifts.

In a marriage proposal, it is not the gift that should come first but the person with whom you are deciding to spend the rest of your life with.

He or she has to be assessed beyond any Greek gift. Don't get trapped and lose your right senses through the gifts. Even when the givers are married, be careful. Sometimes, such gifts come with hidden motives. First determine the intention of the giver. More so, desist from accepting gifts from anyone you have not established a relationship with because reciprocation might be demanded.

Surely oppression maketh a wise man mad; and a GIFT destroyeth the heart. – Ecclesiastes 7:7

And thou shalt take no GIFT: for the gift blindeth the wise, and perverteth the words of the righteous. – Exodus 23:8

A wicked man taketh a GIFT out of the bosom to pervert the ways of judgment. – Proverbs 17:23

Following someone you do not know well to a place you do not know as well.

I have seen so many examples of this particular situation that I had to ask whether their brains were taken out of their skulls when they chose to go. How can you be meeting someone for the first time, and you are following him or her home? You get yourself into trouble because this fellow is still a stranger to you, no matter how many hours you have discussed. This is why some singles disappear without trace and you never hear about them again. The fellow you are following might have an intention that is totally different from yours.

Presently, I have two people I am praying for who followed strangers and were hypnotized, and thereby lost their right senses. Avoid making this selfinduced mistake that may give you a scar that remains unhealed all the days of your life. Even those that eventually escape from such trap never fully recover. Beware and be warned. Make sure you prayerfully consider any relationship before committing yourself into it. You might need a chaperon or go with another friend for a date you are not too certain about.

Do not follow anyone into any ungodly places such as bars, clubs, brothels, shrines, groves or a forest in the name of 'catching fun'. It is equally dangerous for ladies to accept lift from total strangers or for guys to pick up women of easy virtues.

And Jesus answered and said to them, 'See to it that no man misleads you... Matthew 24:4

Matthew 15:14b And if the blind lead the blind, both shall fall into the ditch.

Not taking your spiritual life seriously.

The truth is this, the more spiritual you are, the better things become. The reverse is also true, the less spiritual you are the worse things become. At the Mountain of Fire and Miracles Ministries, we have recorded several testimonies where old couples give birth to their first child at advanced ages, the most recent one involve a couple of 60 and 56 years respectively. There is nothing the Almighty cannot do, and with the great testimonies the Lord is giving us in our Singles' Forum today, there is no point in giving up. Marriage is your *kingdom right* as a believer; you must partake and see that the Lord is good indeed. Don't give up, neither should you give in. Check up your family history if there is any pedigree of marital failure or breakups. Go for counseling sessions with Christian counselors. Try to let go of past unfavorable experience. Trust God to heal you psychologically and spiritually.

For ye have need of patience, that, after ye have done the will of God, ye might receive the promise. For yet a little while, and he that shall come will come, and will not tarry. Now the just shall live by faith: but if any man draw back, my soul shall have no pleasure in him. If you allow yourself to be distracted by your past unpleasant experiences, things will get worse and degenerate so much that if you are not careful, you might lose interest in getting married. This is a dangerous mistake and the devil's lie, don't give in to it. You must realize that there is no way to change the past; what has happened has happened. When we get hurt or disappointed, God is not ignorant about it. He desires we learn from events of the past so that we can become better. No wonder God did not allow the past event to kill you; He has a better agenda for your life! Holding unto the past could be taken advantage over by the devil to torment, derail, delay and destroy your glorious destiny; so don't allow him beloved.

When you still live in your past, it is a sign that you have not forgiven yourself and anyone involved in the event. By so doing, you have entered a spiritual contract of closed heaven.

Make up your mind to continue the journey and with God on your side, you shall become victorious.

Remember ye not the former things, neither consider the things of old. Behold, I will do a new thing; now it shall spring forth; shall ye not know it? I will even make a way in the wilderness, and rivers in the desert. Isaiah: 43: 18-19

Dating married men or women.

If you are looking for a relationship that will definitely end in marriage, it should not be with a married man. Going out with a married man is adultery which is a wrong foundation for any matrimony. All married men that are busy running after single ladies are wicked and heartless. Good men or women don't behave like that. If you allow them to pollute your life, the period you spend with them, no matter how short, may require years to payback. As a single lady, when you give in to the advances of a married man, know for sure that he is just in your life to fill the gap his wife left opened in his life. And sincerely what they need you for is to quench the thirst of the sexual urge with your body. This is very unfortunate. Even if the man decides to make you have babies for him, it does not change the situation; you are simply a *bond concubine* that can never experience the beauty of true marriage. Because the man has to keep you away from his siblings or friends in order to avoid a fight with the legal wife at home. If you allow yourself to enter into this mess, you have simply *chosen* to be a secondclass wife and a degraded human being. You should know however, that God has a better plan for you; an original plan of blissful matrimony, if you can only be focused and patient.

Some unfortunate ladies go to the extent of competing with the married man's wife who is fetish, thereby inviting spiritual and diabolic battles they should not have had anything with.

Some allow themselves to be handled anyhow by their senior officers, while some even sleep with their bosses *in* the office. This kind of life does not help your destiny at all, so never consent to a married man or woman.

Dating a married person is a sign that you are not ready to settle down in marriage, hence stop if you plan to marry blissfully. It also means you are not ready to find your own partner, since you have attached yourself to another person's partner. You have to break up urgently. No matter the boast of your married partner, he or she does not truly love you. If he or she did, they would let you go find your own spouse. Dating a married person makes you the 'other' person in the relationship: the home-wrecker. If you share another person's spouse, be ready to share yours also. This act makes you a breaker of divine law, an enemy of God and a defiler of the divine institute called marriage.

Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap. Gal: 6:7

My son, if sinners entice thee, consent thou not. Proverbs 1:10

Random sampling! Being too easy.

Guys are the ones involved in the random sampling syndrome while the ladies who are seen as cheap-to-catch fish. As a lady, note that we men like a bit of being 'challenged' and if they end up in bed with you after the first date, they are unlikely to have any respect for you. Make the man work for your love, but don't overdo it.

And as a guy, jumping from one lady to another in the name of dating or in search of the most compatible bedmate is a great mistake. It is both spiritually and physically unsafe (Sexually Transmitted Diseases).

Spiritually, when you sleep with this person today, the Bible says you have become one flesh. So becoming one flesh with all the people you have sampled round shows how fragmented your life or soul would be. To be successful in any venture after series of sexual escapades might be difficult. This is because the person is no longer a complete human being: sex has fragmented his or her life and distributed it among sex partners. What a tragedy!

Pray to be led by God for a good partner; don't be moved by the facial appearance. Dating has never helped choosing marriage partner; it's a trial and error method that could put you into an irrecoverable error. Stop it. As a lady, give yourself some self-worth before the man who would seek your hand in marriage.

Give not thy strength unto women, nor thy ways to that which destroyeth kings. Proverb: 31:3

Who can find a virtuous woman? for her price is far above rubies. The heart of her husband doth safely trust in her, so that he shall have no need of spoil. Proverb:31:10-11

Wasting too much time on unavailable men or women.

That is, this person not interested in you, whether in person or in marriage, and you are wasting your time and life waiting for him or her to have a change of mind. If you are a guy, waiting is part of the process to get what you really want, but as a lady, it is sheer wastage.

If you fall into the category of such ladies or men that refuse to consider any other proposal, or make other proposal simply because the person you have an eye on has not proposed, you are a joker. In a way, you have belittled yourself before that person; he will never consider you as a spouse because you have given him a whole episode of who you really are. This is very sad.

Waiting without something tangible for a whole year or more is a great mistake. This is not proper in any love relationship: avoid it. To you guys, even if the lady has taken much time before giving you some attention, you had better forge ahead after involving a Christian marriage counselor or pastor. While the waiting process is on, avoid buying your way through his or her heart with gifts. If you do, it will take more gifts to sustain the relationship and marriage. **Exo.23:8**.

To you ladies, don't waste your precious time for a man who does not want you; if you force yourself on him, he might maltreat you later on.

Will you set your heart on that which is not...? Proverbs 23:5

Giving an intended spouse unfettered access to your money or possession.

There is a huge difference between a marriage and a courtship. During courtship, you are intending to get married, not married yet. Do you know that anything can still happen that will make the marriage not to hold? I am not praying failure for you beloved, just sounding a note of warning on how to go about things before marriage. The truth is that it's not every courtship that actually leads into marriage, hence giving a guy or a lady the full access to your money or property might be unsafe for you. It is foolhardy and you could be taken advantage of.

Some financially stable ladies lose their senses immediately they find a man that says, 'I love you'. They will be ready to spend their last penny on him. This is a serious mistake and one of its dangers is that the money may become what drives the man in the relationship and not his *real* love for you. If you are in a relationship with a man or a lady who always asks you for gifts, money and material possession, be rest assured that you are already trapped, because this is abnormal. In order to avoid being heartbroken, please avoid this silly mistake.

A fool and his money are soon parted. (English proverb). Since you are not married yet, don't open up your finances, no matter your trust level for your partner. If you withhold your finances from him or her, it is another way you could train and build trust and love for each other, without any material influence.

Do not even combine your bank account yet until you are married. Do not allow his or her lack to change your decision; don't give your partner an unfettered access to your money.

A good name is to be chosen rather than great riches, and loving favor rather silver and gold. – Proverbs 22: 1

Give not thy strength unto women, nor thy ways to that which destroyeth kings. – Proverb: 31:3

Being too picky and judgmental.

A picky person is **hard to please and has** inflexible likes and dislikes and, therefore, being hard to please or satisfy. As a lady, if you have this character, you will miss some good men as you will avoid getting close to them to really know them. But if you allow common sense to prevail and you move closer to such guys, you'll realize they have some good qualities that can make a marriage work. So know that no one is perfect. Stop complaining over everything and almost everybody. In most cases, it is those that have one complaint or the other against people that usually have problems. This is a character disorder that needs to be addressed.

Respect individuals for who they are. Remind yourself daily that no one is perfect, including you and know for sure too that he or she has the natural ability to be better, most especially as a believer. More importantly too, be reminded that being judgmental could make you lose your partner's attention in the relationship, thereby exposing you to the risk of losing the relationship entirely.

Judge not, that ye be not judged. For with what judgment ye judge, ye shall be judged: and with what measure ye mete, it shall be measured to you again. And why beholdest thou the mote that is in thy brother's eye, but considerest not the beam that is in thine own eye? Matthew :7:1

Telling lies to your partner.

A relationship based on lies will never survive, no matter how you try to cover up. It may sound awful but if you already have children, you have to tell your partner because the day he or she discovers on his or her own, it will almost be impossible to mend the crack that will be created.

When you tell lies, and it backfires later, it becomes a huge problem. I have so many examples of this situation and the relationships involved will really take divine intervention to survive. The problem is that once your partner finds out that you have not been truthful, faith in his or her ability to trust the safety of your responses has been shaken. After all, if he or she can't trust you to say how **it really** is, who can he or she trust? And, can he or she believe lots of other things you have said?

Some tell themselves (and sometimes other people as well) that they are really lying to protect their partner. But is this true? Or are they really lying because they want to protect themselves from having a fight, from their own anxiety about disappointing their partner, or from some other potentially unpleasant consequence that might result from telling the truth? There are kind and respectful ways to communicate the truth. It doesn't have to be abrasive, harsh or mean. People say they tell lie in order to avoid conflict but you must also count the cost by the time your lie is detected. If there is anything you are doing and you think your partner must not know about it, you better stop it because, it could cause a problem you cannot handle. Lying to your partner could cost you the relationship you cherish so much. Please stop it beloved.

For he flattereth himself in his own eyes, until his iniquity be found to be hateful. The words of his mouth are iniquity and deceit: he hath left off to be wise, and to do good. Psalms: 36:2-3

32 Double-dating or flirting with others.

I am aware so many people get themselves involved in having more than one relationship, holding the opinion that if one fails, the other should work. Some singles keep more than one partner because they are simply unserious and they are not yet sure of what to do with their lives.

Apart from the fact that this is sinful, it is a way to put your integrity and destiny at risk. If your multiple partners find out about your 'games', they will strategize on how to really use you or get back at you since they know you might not marry them. This is even beyond an ordinary mistake, it is very dangerous too.

More so, I need to sound this note of warning to anyone reading this book. If you are in a relationship with someone you have discovered keeps other relationships, you better sit him or her down and reach conclusions. If you continue in the relationship, believing that he will change or dump other partners for you, you might be day-dreaming.

There is no good marriage that begins on such polluted foundation. Be sure you know what you are doing in your relationship. In the first instance, you should not even start any relationship without being ready to marry. So, avoid this fatal mistake.

One of the main reasons why you must stop this is because it is a great sin in the sight of God. Stop it because it is not safe for your health and because your integrity is seriously at stake. If you don't stop, you might fall victim and have a battered image that would discourage any potential spouse.

Starting a focusless relationship.

In marriage counseling, what we advise singles is never to go into any relationship with anyone, except they have decided to marry each other. The importance of a relationship is to get to know each other better since both of you will be spending the rest of your lives together and this is supposed to be courtship. If you are not planning to marry someone, why will you ask them out? For what beloved?

As a lady, if a guy asks you out, make sure he lets you know why or the reason for the relationship. Sincerely, there is no need to go into any

relationship which is not meant to lead to marriage.

Don't live a trial-and-error lifestyle in your marital journey, it is very unsafe, unclean and a big mistake. Only consider courtship at a time in your life when you are ready to consider marriage.

Write down your expectations in your newly found relationship and strictly pursue them with prayers. Make sure you and your partner reach agreements and goals for the relationship before going deep into it.

For which of you, intending to build a tower, sitteth not down first, and counteth the cost, whether he have sufficient to finish it? Lest haply, after he hath laid the foundation, and is not able to finish it, all that behold it begin to mock him, Saying, This man began to build, and was not able to finish. Luke: 14: 28-30

Being overbearing in a relationship means one of you tries to be highly domineering. It is a danger signal that there might be communication problem in the marriage. Marriage relationship should be a mutual thing whereby each of you is supposed to learn from each other. Even as the man, it is wrong for you to try to dominate your partner. Allow her contributions and reason together.

Remember you can't know it all and two good heads are better than one. So be informed today that this is a grand mistake you must correct or not make at all.

You must learn to listen-to each other and take pieces of advice from each other. Never try to dominate any decision-making discourse between both of you. You will even get the best out of your partner if you make him or her feel how important his or her opinions are on any issue. And whenever you are to reach an agreement, take your profession or qualification out of it. Forget about any thing that might bring out your bossy nature.

Submitting yourselves one to another in the fear of God. Eph:5:21

Trying too hard to impress.

No matter the situation surrounding your life or relationship, you must always be yourself. It is deceptive to give a person a different picture of who you are; even in your imperfection, be real. The truth is that no matter how you hide who you really are, one day the traces will unfold, thereby making both of you chronic enemies.

Don't ever pretend in order to lure someone into a relationship or even marriage; the end could be too sad to bear. Be a sincere and truthful Christian.

Seek to be proud of what God has made you. By doing so, you will boost your personal self-esteem. If you have tried your best to get someone's attention (which may go beyond marriage relationship) and it appears difficult, you better look elsewhere. Don't try to say or act what you are not but by the, time you get what you want be sure that your real self will eventually show up.

For am I now seeking the approval of man, or of God? Or am I trying to please man? If I were still trying to please man, I would not be a servant of Christ. Galatians 1: 10 (ESV)

Being ignorant of the mystery of spiritual marriage.

You must accept the fact that spirit husband and spirit wife exist. You must know that their activities are real in people's lives which include delay in marriage and so many others. If you are ignorant of this fact and you do not address it, it may be what is responsible for some marital challenges you and many other singles are facing today.

Spiritual marriage is orchestrated by the satanic kingdom to counter the physical one. Right from the beginning the devil competes with God in so many ways. He tries to deform His beautiful creation, by attacking the first marriage and actually succeeded. At a time also, there was an unpleasant hybrid that came in between the physical and the spiritual beings in Genesis 6:1-2. God disapproved it.

Marriage was instituted by God as a covenant relationship between a human male and a human female and he enacted some principles to go with it; it's supposed to be a union between a man and a woman. But you need to know today that the devil has *counterfeited* this system too. Hence marriage now exists between the physical and spiritual beings. This is what I mean when I talk about spiritual marriage. There are signs victims of this system see: having sex in the dream, constant disappointment in marital relationships, etc. These spiritual spouses are delicately jealous. They never allow rivalry, and that is why they make sure the earthly marriage of their victims are battled or never exist, at all. You must understand this phenomenon and break free if you are affected.

Check your dream life; if you have sex in your dreams, you need to pray against any existing spirit spouse.

If you have been having marital challenges, pray enquiry prayers to know what is wrong because most marital problems are sponsored by the spirit spouses.

Then I strictly advise you go for deliverance from the grip of spirit husband or wife.

But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned. 1 Cor: 2: 14

Going out with someone who never Makes you a priority.

If you are not a priority in his or her life, you are not valued. If you are still going about with this person; it is a mistake. In case you have not prayed properly, you can go back and pray again. If you choose to stick with someone who does not value you or respect you for whom you are, then you are in a very wrong relationship. So many singles put up with their partners, despite the way he or she mishandles them, because they are afraid of not getting stranded. Consider this carefully: marriage is not what you should see as a sort of experiment; it could land you in perpetual pain throughout your life time if you do.

I advice you sit down and re-evaluate what you are doing, re-evaluate your life and the decision you have taken in case you might need to pray more to be sure whether God is involved or not. Then seek for spiritual counsel in a Bible-believing church. I tell you that it is better to remain unmarried rather than being married and wallowing in a serious mess.

Going into a marriage because a prophet says so.

I must tell you this that your best prophet is you. You should develop yourself to the level where you have to personally hear God clearly or else you won't be far from being deceived. The prophet you are consulting is not the one who will be in that marriage; it is you and you alone. Several people have come to me wanting me to prophetically choose the ideal man for them from their prepared list. I don't do such things; you are actually in the best position to know the best man God has for you. Even if a prophet must be involved in your marital choice-making, he or she must only play a confirmatory role and not a major one. Know for sure that marriage is personal; never rely solely on what a prophet says, you must also pray for personal conviction. Also know that a prophet can only give you a marriage and never a home, so be careful.

Looking for a partner in order to hurt your parents.

If your parents have been harassing you, and causing you some embarrassing moment over marital issue, getting back at them by marrying someone they don't approve is a big mistake. This will land you in a serious error. To recover from such error might be almost impossible, so it is better you avoid such things. You may discover that you will remain sad after you have achieved your vengeful goal. Don't do it beloved, marriage is too delicate to be used as a weapon of revenge.

No matter what your parent/guardian did to you in the past, it could be difficult, but you must let it go if you must blissfully move on in life. Ask for forgiveness from God, forgive your parents/guardian and also forgive yourself. Act.17:30. Make sure you settle all conflict with your parents/guardian before stepping out to marry. Visit them and kneel to tell them how sorry you are, even if they are guilty, by so doing you will lift unnecessary embargo away from your head and ways to all-round breakthroughs. Exodus 20:12. If your parents do not want to see you, call the adults they would honour in the family to go with you to beg. You can also involve the church (I mean your pastor). Avoid being arrogant, you might never be able to bear the cost of your action.

In case you are currently having problem with your parents, go extra miles to get it settled and avoid attracting any negative words from them over your life. Honour thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee. Exo:20:12

Lack of preparation for marriage.

If you want to marry and marry rightly, you must prayerfully prepare with the word of God being very active in your life. Normally, anything you want to do in this life, there must be some level of preparation, and marriage is one of those things that demand our totality before you go ahead with it.

Also in preparing for marriage, make sure you already have your goals penned down; financial goal, material goal, number of children you intend to have, how to raise your kids, etc. When you plan, a lot of things will move on smoothly for you; you would be able to speculate demands ahead and make provisions for them.

First identify the reasons why you want to get married; they might point out your preparation or readiness level. Even if you are not engaged yet, identify whom you can marry (someone who shares the same belief with you about God, perspectives of life or someone who has promising features to improve on your destiny) or who you cannot; then map out your preparation strategies. Invest in your marriage with serious and fervent prayers asking God how your marriage should look like; within His perfect will. Carry out spiritual and physical enquiries about marriage in your father and mother's lineage and that of your partner; the facts gathered give you clues to proper preparation. You must be biologically, emotionally, financially and spiritually matured.

Imposing a way of life or character on a person can cause frictions that you might never be able to get over, hence it should be stopped. It can make you lose him or her forever.

This is simply because if things don't work out the way you mapped it, you will definitely always see one reason or the other to quarrel. You will always see the picture of an imperfect, incompetent and unpolished person as your future partner. And anytime you remember he or she is not 'blending' to your unrealistic 'therapy', you become sad and down.

Learn to appreciate your partner for who he or she is, and then be kind and humble enough to grow together. You should try to build up your character to the level of becoming an instrument of great influence.

In other words, if you think your partner is misbehaving in one thing then you can conscious behave rightly to pass the message across to him or her. Don't you ever become rigid and adamant at making the other person behave exactly the way you want. Correct with respect and in love withprayer, then allow God to do the finishing and furnishing job on your partner.

Feeling insecure.

Hacking into emails or phones looking for suspicious messages show you do not trust him or her; then why continue in such relationship?

Give your partner some space. Even if you feel insecure, acting too insecure too soon can switch off the relationship before it starts. Resist the temptation to be constantly checking where he or she is and what he or she is doing and/or thinking and feeling. If you really love your partner, it's natural to be thinking about him or her a lot; but remember he or she had his or her own life before you came along and the life is still there. You must admit the danger you are sowing and you should understand that you might accidently 'break' something you feel is precious, especially in the early 'fragile' stages;

but remember that a flower seed, once planted, needs to be left a bit to the elements rather than being constantly picked and scratched at.

Insecurity drains up the joys in relationships. Insecurity drives people to become too emotionally dependent or needy and this creates problems; you will begin to see problems where none exist. When we become anxious about anything, we start looking for signs of things going wrong. And, of course, we usually find what we are looking for, even if it isn't really there at all. To actually have a smooth relationship by properly handling insecurity, you have to stop confusing weird imagination with reality. There is need to become less domineering. You will know if you are guilty of this feature when you insist your relationship must be exactly as you think it should be, without putting the other person's feeling into consideration is a form of control. A sign of insecurity in relationships is when the desire for certainty becomes too strong. Avoid this, it's a serious mistake!

You must never get married out of pity. Your destiny is too glorious for you to convert it to a mere compensation package.

Find some other way to console him or her. Make sure what is attracting you to him or her is nothing that has to do with his or her painful past. Avoid being overwhelmed by the 'pity story' of anyone to the extent that you don't mind entering his or her life as spouse to fill in the seemingly missing joy. Be careful beloved.

Keep thy heart with all diligence; for out of it are the issues of life. Proverb:4:23

Unplanned pregnancy.

Because you got pregnant accidently is not enough reason for you to marry the person responsible. Of course having a child outside marriage is wrong, but it doesn't mean that you must bury your destiny with that person. The marriage was not properly planned but was entered into as an emergency response measure. Most of such marriages end up in failure.

You must first accept the fact that you have both made a serious mistake to impregnate someone before marriage or to allow yourself to be impregnated. If both of you have agreed to marry each other before the pregnancy, there should be a pause on the marriage plan immediately. The baby should be born first and with the intervention of the Church, a correction marriage can be done. But if both of you never planned to marry each other before the incident, both of you will have to reach a mutual agreement on what to do. That is, how the baby is to be taken care of and what happens after the birth with both of you and marital relationship. The point here is that, it is not automatic to marry each other because of the pregnancy; such decisions could make things worse, instead of better.

Do not base your marital choice on sexual factors; life is more than that. Allowing sex in the relationship may paint a wrong picture of motives or feelings.

A man may seem to love or appreciateyou for the moment because you are satisfying his sexual desires, but that is not real love.

Another ugly experience this carries along is that it does not last before you will get the clearer picture that this is not love, but physical lust. The guy will move on very soon as a butterfly leaves the flower after sucking the juicy nectar.

The first thing you must know is that marriage is not only a physical thing but spiritual as well! Know also that a good sex can only give you pleasure but not a home. Remove this misconception from your brain, it is not true.

But I have a few things against thee, because thou hast there them that hold the doctrine of Balaam, who taught Balac to cast a stumblingblock before the children of Israel, to eat things sacrificed unto idols, and to commit fornication. So hast thou also them that hold the doctrine of the Nicolaitans, which thing I hate. Repent; or else I will come unto thee quickly, and will fight against them with the sword of my mouth. Ignoring unbroken covenants.

The very first description of the nature of marriage in the Bible, as consisting of leaving, cleaving and becoming one flesh (Gen 2:24), reveals the Biblical understanding of marriage as a covenant relationship. However, for the marriage covenant to subsist and to be devoid of satanic attacks and manipulations, all existing covenants must be broken. These include blood covenants with current and past partner, satanic covenants with the marine world, and all forms of witchcraft covenants. Most importantly, the covenants that are entered into consciously and you pray for God to reveal other covenants that you entered into unconsciously. Even if you have so much invested in a relationship but without a formal marriage proposal, you better make your proposal if you are still interested in the fellow.

And as a lady you better call the man and have an open discussion, in order to make things clear, lest you keep wasting your time.

Co-habiting without being legally married.

The Bible makes it categorically clear that the marriage bed is to remain undefiled. Cohabitation of all kinds with unmarried mates of both sexes is ungodly relations which God disapproves. He said in the Book 2 Corinthians that:' *adulterers and fornicators, I will judge.*' Many today scorn the idea of developing a close dependent relationship between husband and wife. They claim that it restricts their freedom and stifles their personal growth. What they advocate can be characterized as a "married singles" lifestyle where both partners continue to follow their independent lives while sharing the same roof and bed. It is not surprising that such relationships often fail, since there is no willingness to leave selfish considerations in order to cleave to each other "for better or for worse, for richer or for poorer, in sickness and in health."

You need to stop staying together; you are not married yet. Incase you have even had children in this condition; you must do correction marriage, thereby legalizing your union.

Please carry your church along for proper directives. Above all, make sure the Lord is glorified in your marriage. If you being convinced to this and you have not done it yet, I beseech you not to do it. If your partner threatens to leave, take you stand that you have chosen to do things rightly to please your Maker; God will never allow shame in your life.

Staying in a relationship for years without knowing each other's relatives.

The Bible says in the book of Genesis, how Abraham sent his servant with many gifts to his relatives in another part of the country to seek a wife for his son. We also read the account of how Jacob worked for his father-in-law for seven years each for each of his wives (Leah and Rachael). This shows that staying in a relationship without knowing or acknowledging each others' relatives is unbiblical. Hence, any marriage relationship you found yourself in which your partner feels reluctant to meet your relations is a questionable one. I am sure there is something he or she is not telling you yet.

If you are taking the relationship seriously, insist to meet his or her parents. Engage him or her in an open communication over the matter incase you might need to rub minds for the solution. If he or she is still reluctant about meeting his or her relations, you have to make up your mind whether the relationship is worth waiting for or whether you should move on with your life. Make sure you do not go ahead to marry without meeting each other's parents. If this is difficult, involve your marriage counselors. **Genesis 24:1-67**

Expecting what you cannot give or willing to give.

A marriage relationship is not a relational prison locking a man and a woman into a permanent relationship. It is rather, to quote a writer, "an elastic link between two hearts." To make this link strong and durable, the partners must be willing to give and give mutually. A partner e.g the man, must not be expecting to receive what he cannot give from the lady.

You need to make up your mind beloved; don't expect your partner or anyone to give you what you cannot give out. Learn to be contented with what you have and avoid being self-centered and excessively demanding. Make your marriage a mutually beneficial relationship.

Going about with someone who loves you behind closed doors but is very distant when with friends or family.

One of the first signs that a man loves a lady or vice versa is that he or she is comfortable in the presence of his or her friends or relatives and accepts them as if they were his relatives. If you are presently going out with someone who claims to love you but is distant or cold towards your relatives, you might want to take a second thought about such relationship, because it is a prerequisite to future disaster.

This is one of the danger signals in courtship you must watch out for, don't ignore it. Ask him or her why he or she behaves that way in case he or she is being misunderstood.

Make communication in the relationship very active; it will handle a lot of issues. Make sure you settle this before marriage.

A friend loveth at all times, and a brother is born for adversity. Proverb:17:17

Open rebuke is better than secret love. Proverb:27:5

58 Love at first sight.

Every love at first sight experience should be subject to serious prayer so that it does not become destruction at first touch. To us mortal beings, the physical stature easily overawes us; even the prophet Samuel made the same mistake when God asked him to go and anoint His servant, and he was carried away by the stature and physique of men. God rebuked him and said; "Do not look at his appearance or at the height of his stature, because I have rejected him; for God sees not as man sees, for man look at the outward appearance, but the LORD looks at the heart" I Samuel 16;7. We should go ahead and do likewise in making marital vows and commitments.

You must accept the truth that you have bee shaded away from the things that matter most in marriage; you better wake up from your slumber and face reality.

You cannot know all about a person within the first contact with him or her, hence falling in love has contracted into the risk of marital failure, therefore have a re-think.

For what man knoweth the things of a man, save the spirit of man which is in him? even so the things of God knoweth no man, but the Spirit of God. 1 Co:2:11

Neglecting career and personal goals.

Though it is not desirable to overemphasize the issue of career and personal goals to the detriment of marital goals and plans, on the converse, it is also despicable to neglect it altogether. Doing this will put the future of the intending couple in jeopardy.

Some ladies refuse to add values to their lives but sit down in a place waiting for Mr Right; it is not wise at all.

In your waiting period, get prepared and upgrade yourself to the point of becoming a helpmeet for your spouse and emerging as a parent that are role models in all facets.

If you are under pressure from your parents (basically their opinion matters a lot here because they seek that you have a good marriage) you need to prayerfully consider the matter.

Avoid any fight or argument with them till you are able to convince them otherwise, in case you are not going for their option.

Withdraw thy foot from thy neighbor's house; lest he be weary of thee, and so hate thee. Proverb:25: 17

Thinking that the only necessary requirement for a relationship is being a churchy person.

In the book of Job, we read the account of how Satan joined 'the Sons of God' when they came to worship in the house of God. This should show us that a mere churchy front should not be the only basis for going into a relationship or committing to someone; the reason being that so many fake Christians are in the world today. Like God said in the book of Isaiah, there are those who draw near to me with their lips, but their hearts are far away from me." So never believe all of those in the church today are true Christians; I mean born-again.

God forbid, we have had cases of people that picked up their spouse from the church and yet regret the act. It takes God to know who is good and faithful, beloved.

Know for sure that, as a believer, the only person you are supposed to marry should also be a child of God, nothing less. You also note here that every child of God may have different degrees in their compatibility to you; hence you need the gift of discernment to actually get the best for yourself Avoid basing your judgment on a person's spiritual status by placing too much emphasis on his or her spiritual engagement or activities.

"... And Jesus answered and said unto her, Martha, Martha, thou art careful and troubled about many things: But one thing is needful: and Mary hath chosen that good part, which shall not be taken away from her. Luke 10:38-42

Thinking you can never do Without a person.

Another grave mistake singles commonly make is to think that a mate is indispensable. This is usually the case with the ladies; anytime the guy start showing some signs of unseriousness, they start to break down and beat themselves over the head. But the fact is that no partner is indispensable in a Christian relationship; if the two are destined to be together and the relationship has been sanctioned by God, then they surely will consummate the relationship.

First change your thinking and mindset. Ph'p:4:8: Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things are honest, whatsoever things are just, whatsoever things are pure, whatsoever things are lovely, whatsoever things are of good report; if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, think on these things. Focus on developing yourself in all ramifications. Prioritize your life:

Manage your emotions by subjecting it under total control of yourself and the Holy Spirit.

Making the opposite sex your best friends, even while in a relationship.

It should be borne in mind that the marriage relationship is a covenant one between the wife and the husband, and the bible teaches that the man will LEAVE his father and his mother and CLEAVE to his wife and the two shall become ONE flesh. But it is better to get best friends of the same sex to avoid comparing your partner with best friends of opposite sex. Note that any relationship outside your rightful courtship can lure your heart away.

But king Solomon loved many strange women, together with the daughter of Pharaoh, women of the Moabites, Ammonites, Edomites, Zidonians, and Hittites; Of the nations concerning which the LORD said unto the children of Israel, Ye shall not go in to them, neither shall they come in unto you: for surely they will turn away your heart after their gods: Solomon clave unto these in love. 1 King: 11:1-2

You meet there have probably been drinking and will not be on their best behavior. If you want to meet good men, go to where they are: at work, at study, or at play and in the gathering of the children of God. Spend time in places where the type of man you're looking for is likely to be. This may involve joining a group, doing a class, or starting a job in a particular field of interest. Matthew 6:21: For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also.

Believing that women are interested in that macho nonsense.

There should be a defined focus in every relationship. Being hurt is something you can't avoid especially after a serious mistake, but being miserable is what you should avoid -it's always a choice. Negative thinking creates negative results. Positive thinking creates positive results. Things always turn out best for people who make the best out of the way things turn out.
- 6. Your mistakes and failures should be your motivation, not your excuse. Learn to work despite your mistakes and failures by placing them under your feet and use them as stepping stones. Take mistakes and failures in stride. They should become your building blocks for your success mansions. Mistakes teach you important lessons in life. Every time you make one, it means you are one step closer to your goal, if you react the right way. The only mistake that can truly hurt you is choosing to do nothing simply because you are too scared to make a mistake. Failure is not falling down; Failure is staying down when you have the choice to get backup.
- 7. Mistakes are rarely as bad as they seem, so stop giving your mistakes the kudos they don't deserve. Mistakes, failures and setbacks are rarely as bad as they seem, and even when they are, they give us an opportunity to grow stronger. So stop giving your mistakes the kudos or attention they don't deserve. You should never let one dark cloud cover the entire sky. The sun is always shining on some part of your life.

Sometimes you just have to forget how you feel, remember what you deserve, and keep pushing forward. God is always nearby to help. Just call Him into the matter.



There are some families in which nobody has ever done any proper marriage among them. What they do is to get pregnant or impregnate someone and nothing more. If you as a believer now choose to be different, you should know for sure that the devil will fight hard to make sure you repeat the same family mistake. So if you fall into this category, you have a battle to fight but the good news is that the Lord is available to help you.


