

Praying & Utilizing the Word of God in Spiritual Warfare 10-19-25

Psalms 144:1 Blessed be the LORD my strength, which teacheth my hands to war, and my fingers to fight:

2 Samuel 22:35 He teacheth my hands to war; so that a bow of steel is broken by mine arms.

For those who pray for no retaliation and such like in your prayers in Jesus Christ's Name, these verses can be used to the supported truth in His Holy Word.

Isaiah 54:17 No weapon that is formed against thee shall prosper; and every tongue that shall rise against thee in judgment thou shalt condemn. This is the heritage of the servants of the Lord, and their righteousness is of me, saith the Lord.

Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

Proverbs 26:2 As the bird by wandering, as the swallow by flying, so the curse causeless shall not come.

Philippians 2:9 Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name:

Nahum 1:8-9

8 But with an overrunning flood he will make an utter end of the place thereof, and darkness shall pursue his enemies.

9 What do ye imagine against the Lord? he will make an utter end: affliction shall not rise up the second time.

When you're praying a warfare prayer, you can include these verses and ask God to cause the enemy to come to an utter end.

Another good one is Jeremiah 20:11 But the Lord is with me as a mighty terrible one: therefore my persecutors shall stumble, and they shall not prevail: they shall be greatly ashamed; for they shall not prosper: their everlasting confusion shall never be forgotten. We can ask the Lord Jesus Christ to go forth as a mighty terrible one against the enemy causing them to stumble.

We can command in Jesus Christ's Name that they will not prevail or prosper but be greatly put to shame for the glory of Father God. Also you can request or command they forever have everlasting confusion in Jesus Christ's Name without any retaliation or evil actions or such like in all God's existence, knowledge and understanding in Jesus Christ's Name. This includes no astral visitors and such like too.

Then remind Father God what His Word says in Isaiah 55: 11 So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I

please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it. Then tell Him in Jesus Christ's Name you expect Him to back His Word up but all according to His perfect will.

More examples:

1. Weapon of Lack of Knowledge

Using this weapon in battle can cause the enemy to become ignorant and unlearned and unable to comprehend what they do study, even causing them to forget how to read...anything in Jesus Christ's Name. Utilize it to cause a lack of knowledge that will lead to their destruction, or for those that's still needed, this lack of knowledge will cause them to go into captivity. Use this when you learn the enemy has been monitoring you or planning an attack to cause the knowledge to become lacking and unlearned throughout the whole kingdom of darkness in Jesus Christ's Name.

Isaiah 29:12 And the book is delivered to him that is not learned, saying, Read this, I pray thee: and he saith, I am not learned.

Hosea 4:6 My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge: because thou hast rejected knowledge, I will also reject thee, that thou shalt be no priest to me: seeing thou hast forgotten the law of thy God, I will also forget thy children.

2 Timothy 3:7 Ever learning, and never able to come to the knowledge of the truth.

Isaiah 5:13 Therefore my people are gone into captivity, because they have no knowledge: and their honourable men are famished, and their multitude dried up with thirst.

Psalms 73:22 So foolish was I, and ignorant: I was as a beast before thee.

Isaiah 56:10 His watchmen are blind: they are all ignorant, they are all dumb dogs, they cannot bark; sleeping, lying down, loving to slumber.

Acts 4:13 Now when they saw the boldness of Peter and John, and perceived that they were unlearned and ignorant men, they marvelled; and they took knowledge of them, that they had been with Jesus.

1 Corinthians 14:38 But if any man be ignorant, let him be ignorant.

2. Stars in Heaven: (#1 101 Weapons)

Sent out in Jesus Christ's Name to attack any astral traveler, jumper and such like so that their mission utterly fails, comes to utter destruction. (Nahum 1:9) until after the 3 days of darkness lifts.

Judges 5:20 They fought from heaven; the stars in their courses fought against Sisera.

Nahum 1:9 What do ye imagine against the LORD? he will make an utter end: affliction shall not rise up the second time.

3. Strong delusion

A delusion sent by God that is specified by Him or of your choosing (Led by the sweet Holy Ghost) that is contrary to the reality of what really is. It also causes fear. (Works well with the terror by night and also the fear by night in Dk olukoya's 101 weapons #29).

Definition of delusion: A delusion is a fixed, false belief that is maintained despite evidence to the contrary. In simple terms, it's a strong conviction in something that isn't true and is often implausible or impossible. Unlike a simple misconception, a delusion is held with absolute certainty and is not based on sensory perception.

2 Thessalonians 2:11-12

¹¹ And for this cause God shall send them strong delusion, that they should believe a lie:

¹² That they all might be damned who believed not the truth, but had pleasure in unrighteousness.

Isaiah 66:4 I also will choose their delusions, and will bring their fears upon them; because when I called, none did answer; when I spake, they did not hear: but they did evil before mine eyes, and chose that in which I delighted not.

Note: False peace is a type of delusion that can be sent out ahead of sudden destruction which the enemy cannot escape from by word or vision.

1 Thessalonians 5:3 For when they shall say, Peace and safety; then sudden destruction cometh upon them, as travail upon a woman with child; and they shall not escape.

Jeremiah 6:14 They have healed also the hurt of the daughter of my people slightly, saying, Peace, peace; when there is no peace.

Ezekiel 13:10 Because, even because they have seduced my people, saying, Peace; and there was no peace; and one built up a wall, and, lo, others daubed it with untempered mortar:

Ezekiel 13:16 To wit, the prophets of Israel which prophesy concerning Jerusalem, and which see visions of peace for her, and there is no peace, saith the Lord God.

She-bears

This weapon sends out 2 angry she-bears that tear and kill 42 children at a time. The children in the warfare are the children of the fallen ones: Nephilim, hybrids, mutated DNA and such like. (Friendnemies)

2 Kings 22:24 And he turned back, and looked on them, and cursed them in the name of the LORD. And there came forth two she bears out of the wood, and tare forty and two children of them.

4. Raised Standard

This is a defensive weapon but also an offensive weapon in the Spirit of the Lord (Holy Spirit) rises up as a wind and fights for the righteous, but is a defense because it's in response to when the enemy is pouring their attacks like a rushing flood.

Lift up a standard Strong's H5127 *nûs*: to flee from any person or thing by a confined stream by the wind of God that impels them to flee. abate, away, be displayed, make to flee away, put to flight, hide, lift up a standard.

The word "nus" here is built (in Hebrew, not English) on the Polel stem, meaning its last letter is doubled (now spelled "nuss") and this dramatically adds to the verbal action implied. It's then a super-powerful "Piel" stem verb now. The Holy Spirit **ENERGETICALLY, FURIOUSLY, WITH ALL HIS MIGHT** counteracts that encroaching enemy of our soul! **DILIGENTLY, WHOLE-HEARTEDLY, FERVENTLY**. He lifts up a standard against the enemy.

Isaiah 59:19 So shall they fear the name of the LORD from the west, and his glory from the rising of the sun. When the enemy shall come in like a flood, the Spirit of the LORD shall lift up a standard against him.

5. Slippery places

This weapon causes the enemy's way to be darkened and their feet to be unsure, unsteady and everywhere they step to be slippery causing them to fall down into destruction. In addition these places are dark and a holy angel of the Lord will persecute them causing evil to be brought upon them in their year of visitation from the Lord.

Psalms 35:6 Let their way be dark and slippery: and let the angel of the Lord persecute them.

Psalms 73:18 Surely thou didst set them in slippery places: thou castedst them down into destruction.

Jeremiah 23:12 Wherefore their way shall be unto them as slippery ways in the darkness: they shall be driven on, and fall therein: for I will bring evil upon them, even the year of their visitation, saith the LORD.

War Enhancements For The Righteous.

1. Cloak of Zeal & Garments of Vengeance

Isaiah 59:17

For he put on righteousness as a breastplate, and an helmet of salvation upon his head; and he put on the garments of vengeance *for* clothing, and was clad with zeal as a cloke.

2. Hind's feet

This enhancement gives you the agility and surefootedness of the deer and/or a gazelle and will cause you to be set in a high place away from the enemy's reach by the help of the Lord's holy angels.

A gazelle is a graceful, swift, and sure-footed animal that can climb sheer rocky cliffs and never stumble or fall. In climbing, the deer can place her back feet exactly where her front feet were,

thus needing only two sturdy footrests instead of four. She can scamper across what appears to be a vertical cliff, unafraid and undeterred by seemingly impassable terrain.

Psalms 18:33 He makes my feet like hinds' feet, and sets me upon my high places.

2 Samuel 22:34 He makes my feet like the feet of a deer, and sets me upon my high places.

Habakkuk 3:19

¹⁹ The LORD God is my strength, and he will make my feet like hinds' feet, and he will make me to walk upon mine high places. To the chief singer on my stringed instruments.

Psalms 91:11-12

¹¹ For he shall give his angels charge over thee, to keep thee in all thy ways.

¹² They shall bear thee up in their hands, lest thou dash thy foot against a stone.

Psalms 121:3 He will not suffer thy foot to be moved: he that keepeth thee will not slumber.

3. Holy Gloves of Armour of Righteousness

This armor is for the protection of the left and right hands, clothing like gloves in His righteousness and powered by God..

2 Corinthians 6:7 By the word of truth, by the power of God, by the armour of righteousness on the right hand and on the left,

4. Armor of Light

This armor is for piercing the darkness and drives it away It is powered by Jesus Christ the light of the world who lives inside of you.

Romans 13:12 The night is far spent, the day is at hand: let us therefore cast off the works of darkness, and let us put on the armour of light.

John 8:12 Then spake Jesus again unto them, saying, I am the light of the world: he that followeth me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life.

5. Armor of God

This is the superior armor every Child of God receives but they have to put it on. Each piece grows and adapts as they draw closer to the Lord Jesus Christ but can be removed when someone sins or backslides. Please note that prayer is a part of your offense and defense with this armor.

Ephesians 6:13-18

¹³ Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.

¹⁴ Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness;

¹⁵ And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace;

¹⁶ Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked.

¹⁷ And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God:

¹⁸ Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints;

6. Garment of Praise

This garment drives back heaviness and depression when wearing it. It is at its full strength when the joy of the Lord, your strength is full.

Isaiah 61:3 To appoint unto them that mourn in Zion, to give unto them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they might be called trees of righteousness, the planting of the LORD, that he might be glorified.

Psalms 35:27-28

²⁷ Let them shout for joy, and be glad, that favour my righteous cause: yea, let them say continually, Let the Lord be magnified, which hath pleasure in the prosperity of his servant.

²⁸ And my tongue shall speak of thy righteousness and of thy praise all the day long.

Psalms 89:15 Blessed is the people that know the joyful sound: they shall walk, O Lord, in the light of thy countenance.

Nehemiah 8:10 Then he said unto them, Go your way, eat the fat, and drink the sweet, and send portions unto them for whom nothing is prepared: for this day is holy unto our Lord: neither be ye sorry; for the joy of the Lord is your strength.
