

The Faithfulness of God Inside the 3 Days of Darkness 11-11-25

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God is forever faithful to those who are His. To those who believe on Him through His Son Jesus Christ, having accepted Him as their Lord and Savior.

Deuteronomy 7:9-10

9 Know therefore that the Lord thy God, he is God, the faithful God, which keepeth covenant and mercy with them that love him and keep his commandments to a thousand generations;

10 And repayeth them that hate him to their face, to destroy them: he will not be slack to him that hateth him, he will repay him to his face.

In these verses in Deuteronomy, we see the difference between those who love Father God and Jesus Christ that serve Them, keeping the commandments of the Word of God, and those who do not. This will be the same inside the 3 days of darkness.

Inside the 3 days of darkness, the children of God will go through a refining process, the Refiner's fire so that they will be ready for Christ Jesus' return. Even in this, we will see God's faithfulness performed for those that are His. It is out of His great love and mercy, that these fiery trials are given, so that the children of God can stand pure, clean and acceptable before Him, when Jesus Christ returns for His bride and then presents them to Father God in heaven. Without this final purging, most would not be ready to enter heaven that already makes up His waiting bride.

When we're in the fires being tried and refined, that's when most of us are seeking God more. We're crying out for His help and instructions through our prayers prayed in Jesus Christ Name. It will be the same inside the 3 days of darkness, but unlike the wicked, we do not endure these things alone. Remember Jesus Christ is our High Priest. He gives us His strength and also His Holy Ghost Spirit to those that are His by our new birth in Him. He will be with each of us inside the darkness.

Joshua 1:9 Have not I commanded thee? Be strong and of a good courage; be not afraid, neither be thou dismayed: for the Lord thy God is with thee whithersoever thou goest.

***The Word of God speaks many times about the trying and refining of His saints, meaning those who have accepted Jesus Christ as the Lord.

Job 23:10 But he knoweth the way that I take: when he hath tried me, I shall come forth as gold.

Psalms 17:3 Thou hast proved mine heart; thou hast visited me in the night; thou hast tried me, and shalt find nothing; I am purposed that my mouth shall not transgress.

Psalms 66:8-12

8 O bless our God, ye people, and make the voice of his praise to be heard:

9 Which holdeth our soul in life, and suffereth not our feet to be moved.

10 For thou, O God, hast proved us: thou hast tried us, as silver is tried.
11 Thou broughtest us into the net; thou laidst affliction upon our loins.
12 Thou hast caused men to ride over our heads; we went through fire and through water: but thou broughtest us out into a wealthy place.

***In the Word of God we see example after example, of His faithfulness, but as we can see, those that are His through their new birth in Jesus Christ, shall be tried. They will be put through the Refiner's fire, so they can be tried as silver and gold are done. When we are tested, purged and tried, the end result is the refining and purging has brought forth a pure vessel, with all the impurities separated from it. This is what Father God is doing for His children inside the 3 days of darkness. No sin will be allowed into heaven, so inside the 3 days of darkness each of His children will go through the Refiner's fire. The time inside the 3 days of darkness shall be different for those in the kingdom of darkness and what they shall endure at the hands of a Just God. Again, we see the distinction of God's righteousness toward his children and in justice toward the wicked.

Malachi 3:2-3

2 But who may abide the day of his coming? and who shall stand when he appeareth? for he is like a refiner's fire, and like fullers' soap:
3 And he shall sit as a refiner and purifier of silver: and he shall purify the sons of Levi, and purge them as gold and silver, that they may offer unto the Lord an offering in righteousness.

***Many people, because they have secret hidden fears of dying, may have to face death inside the 3 days of darkness, but in reality we face death everyday. Anyone of us could die suddenly, if God has appointed that to be our day to die at that moment in time. So, why should we allow it to cause us any more fear, as the kingdom of darkness is trying to do? Our God has removed the sting of death for us, when Jesus Christ gave his life freely, and then rose again. He conquered death, so could not hold any of us belong to Him. Jesus Christ holds the keys to death and hell.

Revelation 1:18 I am he that liveth, and was dead; and, behold, I am alive for evermore, Amen; and have the keys of hell and of death.

Hebrews 9:27 And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment:

***As children of the Most High God who serve Him through our new birth in Jesus Christ, we have nothing to fear, because Jesus Christ has conquered all things and placed them under his feet, including fear, fear of death, and death itself. So, no matter what challenges or trials we face, whether it's betrayal, bitterness, doubt or such like we know Jesus Christ will help us if we will let Him inside the 3 days of darkness.

1 Peter 3:22 Who is gone into heaven, and is on the right hand of God; angels and authorities and powers being made subject unto him.

1 Corinthians 15:25-28; 53-57

25 For he must reign, till he hath put all enemies under his feet.
26 The last enemy that shall be destroyed is death.

27 For he hath put all things under his feet. But when he saith all things are put under him, it is manifest that he is excepted, which did put all things under him.

28 And when all things shall be subdued unto him, then shall the Son also himself be subject unto him that put all things under him, that God may be all in all.

53 For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal must put on immortality.

54 So when this corruptible shall have put on incorruption, and this mortal shall have put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written, Death is swallowed up in victory.

55 O death, where is thy sting? O grave, where is thy victory?

56 The sting of death is sin; and the strength of sin is the law.

57 But thanks be to God, which giveth us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.

Ephesians 1:20-23

20 Which he wrought in Christ, when he raised him from the dead, and set him at his own right hand in the heavenly places,

21 Far above all principality, and power, and might, and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this world, but also in that which is to come:

22 And hath put all things under his feet, and gave him to be the head over all things to the church,

23 Which is his body, the fulness of him that filleth all in all.

Hebrews 2:8-18

7 Thou madest him a little lower than the angels; thou crownedst him with glory and honours, and didst set him over the works of thy hands:

8 Thou hast put all things in subjection under his feet. For in that he put all in subjection under him, he left nothing that is not put under him. But now we see not yet all things put under him.

9 But we see Jesus, who was made a little lower than the angels for the suffering of death, crowned with glory and honour; that he by the grace of God should taste death for every man.

10 For it became him, for whom are all things, and by whom are all things, in bringing many sons unto glory, to make the captain of their salvation perfect through sufferings.

11 For both he that sanctifieth and they who are sanctified are all of one: for which cause he is not ashamed to call them brethren,

12 Saying, I will declare thy name unto my brethren, in the midst of the church will I sing praise unto thee.

13 And again, I will put my trust in him. And again, Behold I and the children which God hath given me.

14 Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, he also himself likewise took part of the same; that through death he might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil;

15 And deliver them who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage.

16 For verily he took not on him the nature of angels; but he took on him the seed of Abraham.

17 Wherefore in all things it behoved him to be made like unto his brethren, that he might be a merciful and faithful high priest in things pertaining to God, to make reconciliation for the sins of the people.

18 For in that he himself hath suffered being tempted, he is able to succour them that are tempted.

***We can read examples of God's faithfulness and mercy all throughout the written Word of God. We see how for the children of Israel, He parted the Red Sea, and rained down manna from heaven. We read how Egypt was plagued, the enemy of the Israelites, the children of God, which included 3 days of darkness. Yet God's children were provided for and protected. During all these things obedience to Father God's commands and instructions was a key factor. We also have been given instructions which we are to obey to be protected under His divine protection inside the darkness. So, if we follow these instructions that we have been given to do, those tried, tested and discerned in Jesus Christ's Name that are from Him, we have nothing to fear inside the 3 days of darkness.

***In addition, we must always remember as children of God, we never walk alone. Jesus Christ who's inside us will light our path. He will be our strength, He is our protector, the Good Shepherd. He is our present help in a time of need. The Holy One who conquered death, who has all power, has all things under His feet, has made a public show of the enemy, when we are inside the 3 days of darkness He will be with you. In Him, we can find and rest in His peace, even during the fiery trials that are to come, because He, Father God & Jesus Christ, are faithful, even though at times we are not.

Matthew 28:18 And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth.

John 14:1 Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God, believe also in me.

John 10:14 I am the good shepherd, and know my sheep, and am known of mine.

Isaiah 41:10-13

10 Fear thou not; for I am with thee: be not dismayed; for I am thy God: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee; yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of my righteousness.

11 Behold, all they that were incensed against thee shall be ashamed and confounded: they shall be as nothing; and they that strive with thee shall perish.

12 Thou shalt seek them, and shalt not find them, even them that contended with thee: they that war against thee shall be as nothing, and as a thing of nought.

13 For I the Lord thy God will hold thy right hand, saying unto thee, Fear not; I will help thee.

Psalms 46:1-3

1 God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble.

2 Therefore will not we fear, though the earth be removed, and though the mountains be carried into the midst of the sea;

3 Though the waters thereof roar and be troubled, though the mountains shake with the swelling thereof. Selah.

Deuteronomy 31:6; 8

6 Be strong and of a good courage, fear not, nor be afraid of them: for the Lord thy God, he it is that doth go with thee; he will not fail thee, nor forsake thee.

8 And the Lord, he it is that doth go before thee; he will be with thee, he will not fail thee, neither forsake thee: fear not, neither be dismayed.

Isaiah 51:12 I, even I, am he that comforteth you: who art thou, that thou shouldest be afraid of a man that shall die, and of the son of man which shall be made as grass;

Psalms 27:1-3

1 The Lord is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? the Lord is the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?

2 When the wicked, even mine enemies and my foes, came upon me to eat up my flesh, they stumbled and fell.

3 Though an host should encamp against me, my heart shall not fear: though war should rise against me, in this will I be confident.

2 Timothy 1:7 For God hath not given us a spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.

Psalms 34:4 I sought the Lord, and he heard me, and delivered me from all my fears.

Romans 8:15 For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father.

1 John 4:18 There is no fear in love; but perfect love casteth out fear: because fear hath torment. He that feareth is not made perfect in love.

Light For God's Children Verses:

Psalms 139:11-12

11 If I say, Surely the darkness shall cover me; even the night shall be light about me.

12 Yea, the darkness hideth not from thee; but the night shineth as the day: the darkness and the light are both alike to thee.

Philippians 4:13 I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me.

John 8:12 Then spake Jesus again unto them, saying, I am the light of the world: he that followeth me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life.

Exodus 10:23 They saw not one another, neither rose any from his place for three days: but all the children of Israel had light in their dwellings.

Psalms 18:28 For thou wilt light my candle: the Lord my God will enlighten my darkness.

Psalm 27:1 The Lord is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? the Lord is the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?

Psalms 36:9 For with thee is the fountain of life: in thy light shall we see light.

Psalm 112:4 Unto the upright there ariseth light in the darkness: he is gracious, and full of compassion, and righteous.

Psalm 119:105 Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path

Proverbs 4:18-19

18 But the path of the just is as the shining light, that shineth more and more unto the perfect day.

19 The way of the wicked is as darkness: they know not at what they stumble.

Micah 7:8 Rejoice not against me, O mine enemy: when I fall, I shall arise; when I sit in darkness, the Lord shall be a light unto me.

Matthew 5:14 Ye are the light of the world. A city that is set on an hill cannot be hid.

Luke 1:78-79

78 Through the tender mercy of our God; whereby the dayspring from on high hath visited us,

79 To give light to them that sit in darkness and in the shadow of death, to guide our feet into the way of peace.

Isaiah 42:16:17

16 And I will bring the blind by a way that they knew not; I will lead them in paths that they have not known: I will make darkness light before them, and crooked things straight. These things will I do unto them, and not forsake them.

17 They shall be turned back, they shall be greatly ashamed, that trust in graven images, that say to the molten images, Ye are our gods.

No Light For the Wicked Verses:

Job 5:5-7

5 Yea, the light of the wicked shall be put out, and the spark of his fire shall not shine.

6 The light shall be dark in his tabernacle, and his candle shall be put out with him.

7 The steps of his strength shall be straitened, and his own counsel shall cast him down.

Proverbs 4:19

19 The way of the wicked is as darkness: they know not at what they stumble.

Exodus 10:23 They saw not one another, neither rose any from his place for three days: but all the children of Israel had light in their dwellings

Jeremiah 25:10 Moreover I will take from them the voice of mirth, and the voice of gladness, the voice of the bridegroom, and the voice of the bride, the sound of the millstones, and the light of the candle.

Job 10:22 A land of darkness, as darkness itself; and of the shadow of death, without any order, and where the light is as darkness.

Jeremiah 13:16 Give glory to the Lord your God, before he cause darkness, and before your feet stumble upon the dark mountains, and, while ye look for light, he turn it into the shadow of death, and make it gross darkness.

Darkness @ Noon Verses

Amos 8:9 And it shall come to pass in that day, saith the Lord God, that I will cause the sun to go down at noon, and I will darken the earth in the clear day

Psalms 37:6 And he shall bring forth thy righteousness as the light, and thy judgment as the noonday.

Deuteronomy 28:29 And thou shalt grope at noonday, as the blind gropeth in darkness, and thou shalt not prosper in thy ways: and thou shalt be only oppressed and spoiled evermore, and no man shall save thee.

Job 5:14 They meet with darkness in the day time, and grope in the noonday as in the night.

Psalms 91:5-6

5 Thou shalt not be afraid for the terror by night; nor for the arrow that flieth by day;

6 Nor for the pestilence that walketh in darkness; nor for the destruction that wasteth at noonday.

Isaiah 16:3 Take counsel, execute judgment; make thy shadow as the night in the midst of the noonday; hide the outcasts; bewray not him that wandereth.

Isaiah 59:9-10

9 Therefore is judgment far from us, neither doth justice overtake us: we wait for light, but behold obscurity; for brightness, but we walk in darkness.

10 We grope for the wall like the blind, and we grope as if we had no eyes: we stumble at noon day as in the night; we are in desolate places as dead men.
